VIGILANCE

Thayer Definition: gregoreuo

1. to watch

 metaphorically give strict attention to, be cautious, active
to take heed lest through remission and indolence some destructive calamity suddenly overtake one

VIGILANCE

To be vigilant is to be "staying watchful and alert to danger or trouble." (Webster's New World Dictionary, 1978)

The vigilant Christian is the one who is on the lookout for the enemies of his spiritual, emotional, and physical wellbeing. He is like:

- The soldier at the battle front
- The spy in enemy territory
- The lifeguard at the pool
- The police officer arriving at the crime scene
- The deer and her fawn at the edge of a clearing
- The father with his family in a bad neighborhood

Vigilance is an essential quality for the Christian.

VIGILANCE IN THE NT

The Greek word is translated "vigilant" twice in KJV – BOTH TIMES WITH "SOBER"

A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, <u>vigilant</u>, <u>sober</u>, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach; (1Ti 3:2 KJV)

Be <u>sober, be vigilant</u>; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: (1Pe 5:8 KJV)

It is translated "watch" sometimes with the word "sober" or "pray"

TW0 WORDS FOR SOBER

Thayer Definition: sophron

- 1. of a sound mind, sane, in one's senses
- 2. curbing one's desires and impulses, self-controlled, temperate

Thayer Definition: nepho

- 1. to be sober, to be calm and collected in spirit
- 2. to be temperate, dispassionate, circumspect

SOBER

To be sober is to be "temperate, moderate, serious, solemn, grave or sedate; characterized by reason, sanity or self-control; showing mental and emotional balance; not extreme or extravagant". (Webster's New World Dictionary, 1978)

The opposite of sobriety: would be carelessness, silliness or recklessness.

Lack of sobriety is a real danger for those who, in their joy for the things of God, give themselves over to emotionalism with reckless abandon.

SOBER IN THE NT

For whether we be beside ourselves, it is to God: or whether we be sober, it is for your cause. (2Co 5:13 KJV)

Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us <u>watch</u> <u>and be sober</u>. (1Th 5:6 KJV)

But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. (1Th 5:8 KJV)

A bishop then must ... <u>vigilant, sober</u>, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach; (1Ti 3:2 KJV) But a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, just, holy, temperate; (Tit 1:8 KJV) Even so must their wives be sober ... (1Ti 3:11 KJV)

SOBER IN THE NT

That the <u>aged men</u> be <u>sober</u> ... (*Tit 2:2 KJV*)

That they may teach the <u>young women</u> to be <u>sober</u>, to love their husbands, to love their children, (*Tit 2:4 KJV*)

<u>Young men</u> likewise exhort to be sober minded. (Tit 2:6

Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; (*IPe 1:13 KJV*)

But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore <u>sober</u>, <u>and watch unto prayer</u>. (1Pe 4:7 KJV)

Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: (**1Pe 5:8 KJV**)

VIGILANCE IN LEADERSHIP

- Elders are to be vigilant
 - A qualification (1 Tim 3:2)
 - Their work (Heb 13:17; Acts 20:31; Rev 2:1-7)
- Preachers are to be vigilant (2 Tim 4:2,5)
