## **Key Concepts**

- We each need to be made holy by a radical transformation of focus made possible with the help of the indwelling Holy Spirit.
- Real life change is a joint effort of the desire to live a holy life along with a surrendered dependence upon the sanctifying work of the Spirit.
- The Holy Spirit bears witness that we are God's children so that we can confidently cry out to God as our Father.

# **Explore the Text**

- 4. All the events of life (both good and bad) are pointing toward a united purpose in God's will (vv. 27-30). According to these verses, what is God's ultimate purpose for your life?
