I have a couple of art pieces in my office bearing lines of it, and, of course, this was one of our brother Hugh's favorites to lead. This last verse stuck out to me this time around, maybe partly because of some of our recent lessons and discussions.

"O to grace how great a debtor..." - This reminds me of Jesus' model prayer: "And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors." (Matt. 6:12, NKJV) We are indebted unto God because of our sins and because He gave His Son as the ultimate sacrifice for our sins. We are indeed indebted to God for His mercy and grace, none of which we deserve. This is a song of humility. Though we don't deserve to be in His presence, may we ever be because of His grace, which He freely bestows upon us.

"Let Thy goodness like a fetter Bind my wand'ring heart to Thee." - A fetter is a form of restraint, usually a chain or similar used to restrain a prisoner. May the goodness of God restrain us in His love, binding us always to Him! Though we, like any prisoner - or to utilize another of Jesus' examples, sheep! - may be prone to wandering away from Him, we should be always bound to Him, that we would be willing to return, such as did the prodigal son. (Luke 15:17-27)

"Here's my heart, O take and seal it..." - A seal is not to be broken until the optimal time. We, as Christians, wish to remain faithful until we meet Him in Judgment. May He remove anything that would hinder our faithfulness.
