#### **Easter Every Sunday**

Church attendance across the nation will be greater this Sunday; the number of early morning risers will also be more numerous; and the wearing of new spring finery will be at its peak. It's Easter Sunday!

Some may wonder why the church here does not have a sunrise service or "appropriate" music or sermons, or even a Thursday night communion service. Such wonderers may be visitors to our services, those new to the Lord's church of perhaps even our children. Some may question, "Don't you people believe in Christ's resurrection?"

Most certainly we do! And we do observe his resurrection. But first, let us look at this day called Easter. It originated as a pagan festival honouring Eastra or Ostra, the Teutonic goddess of light and spring. Not until several centuries after Christ was it applied by the Anglo-Saxons to the Lord's resurrection. As for its use in Acts 12:4 (KJV), the original word there is pascha, the Greek word for the Jewish Passover. It is rightly translated in such versions as the American Standard Version. Our Lord did not institute the communion on a Thursday night, but his command to remember Him in this, and the early church's example of observing the Lord's Supper, always related to Sunday.

Our Lord arose on the first day of the week (Mark 16:2). His church began on Pentecost which always fell on the first day, our Sunday (Acts 2). The first century church assembled for worship, including communion, each first day of the week (Acts 20:7; 1 Corinthians 16:1-2). Thus, faithful Christians today meet each Lord's day to worship and serve and celebrate a RESURRECTED Savior as they await his return. In a sense, every Sunday is "Easter" Sunday. Following the pattern is always a safe course. We have no authority for any other special observance of the Lord's resurrection.

As for the wearing of that spring clothing—isn't it a welcome and pretty sight?

What a great reminder by Brother Jim that every Sunday is a time to remember the Lord's resurrection! The Lord's Day (every first day of the week) is the reminder that the grave was empty and that we have new life in Christ in this life as well as a realized hope for spending eternity with our Lord. Historically speaking, a couple hundred years after Christ, the early church began arguing over which day Jesus was crucified and then raised. Some were even celebrating it as a special day. Biblically speaking, however, the apostles leave no instructions regarding anything other than the first day of EACH week. In fact, Romans 6:5 says: "If we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his." In this sense, every day we wake up after having been baptized into Christ's death is, in a sense, an Easter! We have new life in the One who makes us new through His death. Thank you Lord for Jesus. Thank you Lord for new life. Thank you Lord for the resurrection of which Jesus was the first-fruits, but that all who are faithful to Him will participate in. —John
