## Who Should Be Baptized?

The question of who should be baptized often sparks debate, with some relying on human opinions, scholars, or traditions. However, the Bible is the final authority. So, who are the true candidates for baptism?

#### Those Who Have Sinned

Sin separates us from God (Isaiah 59:1-2). Paul wrote, "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). James added that failing to do known good is sin (James 4:17). Everyone of accountable age sins, and baptism is directly tied to forgiveness. Peter told the Jews who crucified Jesus, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized... for the remission of sins" (Acts 2:38). Acts 22:16 and 1 Peter 3:21 confirm that baptism washes away sins. Candidates for baptism understand sin, its consequences, their need for forgiveness, and are willing to repent.

#### **Those Who Believe**

Biblical baptism requires faith. Jesus said, "He who believes and is baptized will be saved" (Mark 16:16). In Acts 2:37-41, Jews who believed Peter's preaching were baptized. Acts 8:12 notes that Samaritans who "believed Philip... concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ" were baptized. Similarly, Acts 18:8 states that Corinthians who heard, believed, and were baptized. In the New Testament, only believers were baptized—not based on others' faith or "the faith of the church," as some traditions claim. Hebrews 11:6 emphasizes that coming to God requires belief in Him and His rewards.

#### **Those Who Repent**

Baptism candidates must desire and be able to repent. John the Baptist urged, "Bear fruits worthy of repentance" (Matthew 3:8). Jesus called for repentance and obedience (Mark 1:15). Peter instructed, "Repent and be baptized" for forgiveness (Acts 2:38). Paul said God commands all to repent (Acts 17:30), and Peter noted God desires all to reach repentance (2 Peter 3:9). Repentance is a change of heart and mind to reject sin and follow Christ, not a prolonged process. In the New Testament, believers repented and were baptized immediately. For example, Paul, after repenting of persecuting the church, was baptized (Acts 22:16). The Jews at Pentecost, after repenting, were baptized (Acts 2:38-41). Others, like those in Acts 8:12-13 and 16:30-33, were baptized promptly after belief and repentance. If, however, repentance in a particular case requires a rejection of ongoing sin (such as an unscriptural marriage), repentance may take longer. Those who recognize the salvation promised in baptism will respond quickly even when repentance promises to be difficult.

#### **Those Who Commit to Live for Christ**

Baptism is for those committed to following Christ, not those unwilling to change their sinful ways or keep God's commands. Jesus instructed His disciples to baptize and teach others to "observe all things that I have commanded" (Matthew 28:20). Acts 2:42 shows that baptized believers continued in the faith. Jesus told the church in Smyrna, "Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life" (Revelation 2:10). Baptism requires a lifelong commitment to Christ.

#### Conclusion

The Gospel must be preached (Mark 16:15), heard (Romans 10:17), believed (Mark 1:15), and obeyed (Romans 10:16). Those who should be baptized are sinners who understand their lost state, believe the Gospel, repent, and commit to living for Christ. Baptism, as an act of faith and obedience, brings God's forgiveness and salvation (1 Peter 3:21). .


