Mission Statement

We exist to save souls in St. Paul/Minneapolis, transforming those souls into the image of Christ, and equipping them for service to the glory of God.

Vision Statement

By 2015 we want to launch a new congregation in the St. Paul/Minneapolis area.

The Numbers

- 5.3 million people statewide
- 2,400 CoC members spread throughout 39 congregations statewide (0.046% of pop.)
- 3-4 million people in the greater Twin Cities area
- Less than 1,500 members of the Church of Christ in the greater Twin Cities area
- 62 out of 87 counties have no Church of Christ (only the Dakota's rank lower)

Current Progress

- Alex lived in the Twin Cities for 2 years (2005-2006)
- 2 Survey trips taken since 2012 to show potential team members the area
- Two families, the Floods and the Wojciks, have committed to being on the mission team
- 2 other couples have been on a survey trip and are still praying about a commitment
- Ongoing search for more interested workers

Timeline

- May 2013: Erin finishes law school, Matt and Ashley graduate SIBI
- July 2013: Erin takes the Minnesota state bar to practice law
- August 2013: The entire mission team will begin the Sunset School of Missions
- December 2013: Complete the Sunset School of Missions
- January 2014: Move up to Minnesota
- 2014: The year of field research
- 2015: The year of launching a new congregation

Plans for 2014

- We plan on being a part of the Woodbury congregation for 2014
- We will help teach and encourage Woodbury while researching the Twin Cities
- We want to experience first-hand and "feel the pulse" of each county so that the best strategically placed congregation can be launched
- Woodbury has agreed to be a local source of wisdom and encouragement as we begin

Our Current Financial Situation

Losses:

- \$241.66 Sudan (the church had to make many other budget cuts as well)
- \$400.00 Individual Supporter
- \$150.00 SIBI Scholarship (for SIBI students only)
- \$260.00 SIBI draft assignments -(For SIBI students only)

Needs:

- Replace at least \$800.00 per month in income for summer and School of Missions
- Raise 5,200 for child birthing expenses
- Raise support needed for our work in Minnesota

Note:
