Tears for the Lost

Jeremiah is referred to as the "Weeping Prophet". In fact ,his second book is called quite appropriately Lamentations. He opens the 1st chapter of Lamentations with the following words. How lonely sits the city that was full of people! How like a widow has she become, she who was great among the nations! She who was a princess among the provinces has become a slave. ² She weeps bitterly in the night, with tears on her cheeks; among all her lovers she has none to comfort her; all her friends have dealt treacherously with her; they have become her enemies. At the end of Jeremiah 8 in verses 18-22, Jeremiah makes this despairing and pained statement of grief, that continues in Jeremiah 9:1 ¹⁸ My joy is gone; grief is upon me; my heart is sick within me. ¹⁹ Behold, the cry of the daughter of my people from the length and breadth of the land: "Is the LORD not in Zion? Is her King not in her?" "Why have they provoked me to anger with their carved images and with their foreign idols?" ²⁰ "The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved." ²¹ For the wound of the daughter of my people is my heart wounded; I mourn, and dismay has taken hold on me. ²² Is there no balm in Gilead? Is there no physician there? Why then has the health of the daughter of my people not been restored? **9** Oh that my head were waters, and my eyes a fountain of tears, that I might weep day and night for the slain of the daughter of my people!

Those are the words of a man who has seen God's people desert God and then God allow them to fall into captivity. His broken heart leaks out of his eyes and stains the parchment with his tears. As I was reading and studying in Jeremiah and Lamentations, this past week, I was struck by the sorrow that Jeremiah felt as he looked at what Judah was in those days and as he remembered what she had been. He enumerated the sins that had led Judah away from her God and he grieved. I began to reflect on how blasé and unconcerned I sometimes became about those that are part of my fleshly family and my spiritual family that have, like Judah of old, wandered away from the Lord. I vowed to myself that I would make more concerted efforts to lead them back to the Lord. Sadly my list grew much longer than I wished just in listing those who have wandered away since we arrived in Trenton nearly 14 years ago.

As I looked at the list, I began to remember happier days spiritually for many of these folks. All of them I love and have tender feelings for in my heart. So many happy memories of happy days when we were together, both physically and spiritually. I remember for almost each one times of laughter and fun. I remember, with many hugs and tears at sad times. Some I even remember hugging as they came out of the watery grave of baptism. Then I think of how infrequently I see them now. I also have a broken heart over their choices and the inevitable result of their decisions. As I look over my list, it becomes difficult to type as I have tears streaming down my face for them and their families without God.

I committed to myself that I would try to contact each one in the next 30 days, either in person or by written communication to tell them that I love them and miss them! Many of you have done this with some but I would challenge you to make your own list and pray to God for His patience to give them time to repent . I also would encourage you to pray for the motivation to seek them out and the wisdom to say the right words. Let's reach out to those that we love while we still can!
