

Are You A Gimper?

You won't find one in the dictionary, but you may find a gimper at work, at church, at school, or on your favorite sports team or - - just about anywhere, but you will have to look hard for them though, because they seem to be rare today. A chaplain speaking at a seminary graduation encouraged students to be a "gimper" for God.

Dr, M. R. DeHaan referred to a gimper as "one who aspires to excel, to be different. A gimper is committed to the core – thoroughly and unequivocally." (Charles Swindoll, Devotions For Growing Strong In The Seasons Of Live, p47) Therefore a gimper is someone who is single mindedly committed, one who is determined to achieve excellence.

Charles Swindoll gives us a comparison of the ordinary man vs. a gimper Christian.
