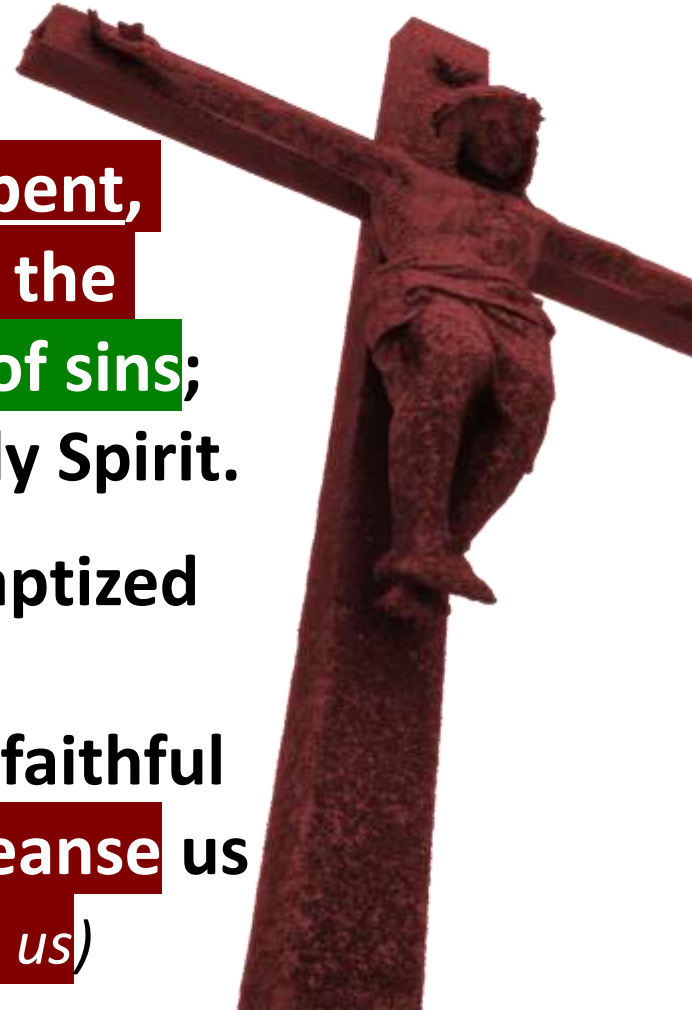
## Redeemed/ Ransome Paid (NKJV)

**Believe- Repent- Confess Jesus- Be Baptized**

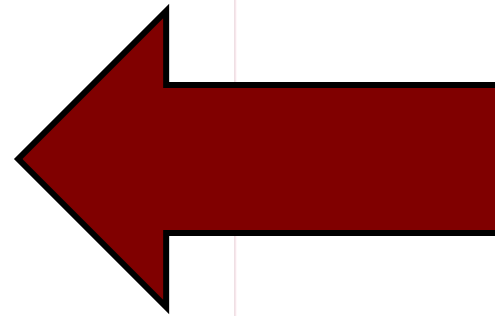
