..be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, **singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord;**

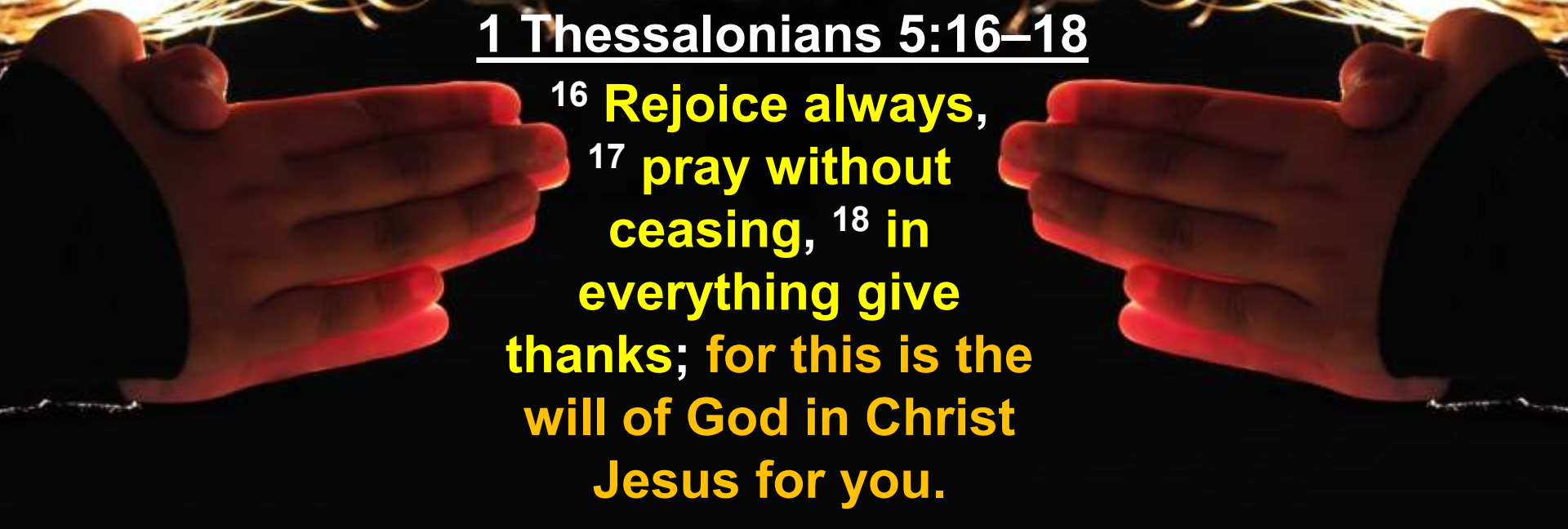
Acts 16:25 **But about midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God,** and the prisoners were listening to them;

Ephesians 2:2 in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to **the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience,**

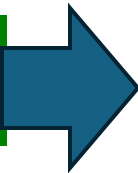

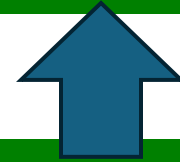

2 Thessalonians 1:7–10

7 .. when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, ⁸ in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁹ These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, ¹⁰ when He comes, in that Day, to be glorified in His saints and to be admired among all those who believe, because our testimony among you was believed.
