



## **Saul took a sword and fell on it** (NKJV)

**1 Samuel 31:1–4** <sup>1</sup> Now the Philistines fought against Israel; and **the men of Israel fled** from before the Philistines, and fell slain on Mount Gilboa.

<sup>2</sup> Then **the Philistines followed hard after Saul** and his sons. And **the Philistines killed** Jonathan, Abinadab, and Malchishua, **Saul's sons**.

<sup>3</sup> The battle became fierce against Saul. **The archers hit him, and he was severely wounded** by the archers.

<sup>4</sup> Then Saul said to his armorbearer, “Draw your sword, and thrust me through with it, lest these uncircumcised men come and thrust me through and abuse me.” But his armorbearer would not, for he was greatly afraid. Therefore **Saul took a sword and fell on it**.



## 1 Samuel 9:1–2

<sup>1</sup> There was a man of Benjamin whose name was **Kish** the son of Abiel, the son of Zeror, the son of Bechorath, the son of Aphiah, a Benjamite, **a mighty man of power.**

<sup>2</sup> And he had **a choice and handsome son** whose name was **Saul.** There was not a more handsome person than he among the children of Israel. From his shoulders upward he was taller than any of the people.

## **And on whom is all the desire of Israel? (NKJV)**

**1 Samuel 9:17–20** <sup>17</sup> So when Samuel saw Saul, the LORD said to him, “**There he is, the man of whom I spoke to you. This one shall reign over My people.**” <sup>18</sup> Then Saul drew near to Samuel in the gate, and said, “Please tell me, where is the seer’s house?” <sup>19</sup> Samuel answered Saul and said, “I am the seer. Go up before me to the high place, for you shall eat with me today; and tomorrow I will let you go and will tell you all that is in your heart. <sup>20</sup> But as for your donkeys that were lost three days ago, do not be anxious about them, for they have been found. **And on whom is all the desire of Israel? Is it not on you and on all your father’s house?”**

**Why then do you speak like this to me?** (NKJV)

1 Samuel 9:21 And Saul answered and said, “Am I not a Benjamite, of the smallest of the tribes of Israel, and my family the least of all the families of the tribe of Benjamin? **Why then do you speak like this to me?”**

1 Samuel 10:1 Then Samuel took a flask of oil and poured it on his head, and kissed him and said: “**Is it not because the LORD has anointed you commander over His inheritance?**”

**1 Samuel 11:1–2, 6** <sup>1</sup> Then **Nahash the Ammonite** came up and encamped against **Jabesh Gilead**; and all the men of Jabesh said to Nahash, “Make a covenant with us, and we will serve you.”  
<sup>2</sup> And Nahash the Ammonite answered them, “**On this condition I will make a covenant with you, that I may put out all your right eyes, and bring reproach on all Israel.**”  
<sup>6</sup> Then **the Spirit of God came upon Saul** when he heard this news, and his anger was greatly aroused.

## **If You..** (NKJV)

**1 Samuel 12:13–15 *Gilgal*** <sup>13</sup> “..here is the king whom you have chosen and whom you have desired...<sup>14</sup> **If you fear the LORD and serve Him and obey His voice, and do not rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then both you and the king who reigns over you will continue following the LORD your God.**

<sup>15</sup> **However, if you do not obey the voice of the LORD, but rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then the hand of the LORD will be against you, as it was against your fathers.**



## **If You..** (NKJV)

**Matthew 7:24–27** <sup>24</sup> “Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: <sup>25</sup> and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock. <sup>26</sup> “But everyone who hears these sayings of Mine, and does not do them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand: <sup>27</sup> and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall.”

## **Two Years Later** (NKJV)

1 Samuel 13:1,5

<sup>1</sup> **Saul** reigned one year; and when **he had reigned two years** over Israel,

<sup>5</sup> **Then the Philistines gathered together to fight with Israel, thirty thousand chariots and six thousand horsemen, and people as the sand which is on the seashore in multitude. And they came up and encamped in Michmash, to the east of Beth Aven.**

**148 Acres/ 20 acres**

## 1 Samuel 13:6–7

**6 When the men of Israel saw that they were in danger (for the people were distressed), then the people hid in caves, in thickets, in rocks, in holes, and in pits.**

**7 And some of the Hebrews crossed over the Jordan to the land of Gad and Gilead.**

**As for Saul, he was still in Gilgal, and all the people followed him trembling.**



## 1 Samuel 13:8

Then he waited seven days,  
according to **the time set by  
Samuel** (vs. 10:8, 13:13).

But Samuel did not come to Gilgal; and  
**the people were scattered  
from him.**


