

² And he said: "I cried out to the LORD because of my affliction, And He answered me. "Out of the belly of Sheol I cried, And You heard my voice.

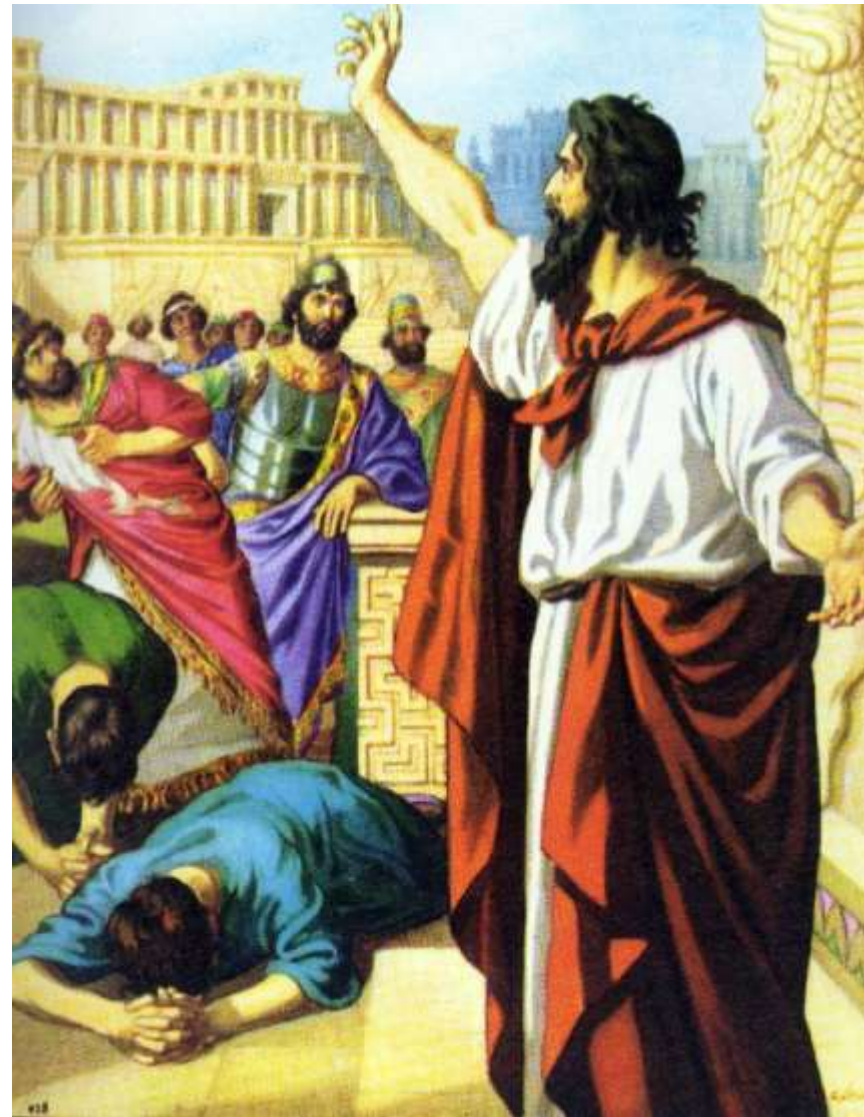


Jonah 3:1–3 (NKJV)

Jonah 3:7–8

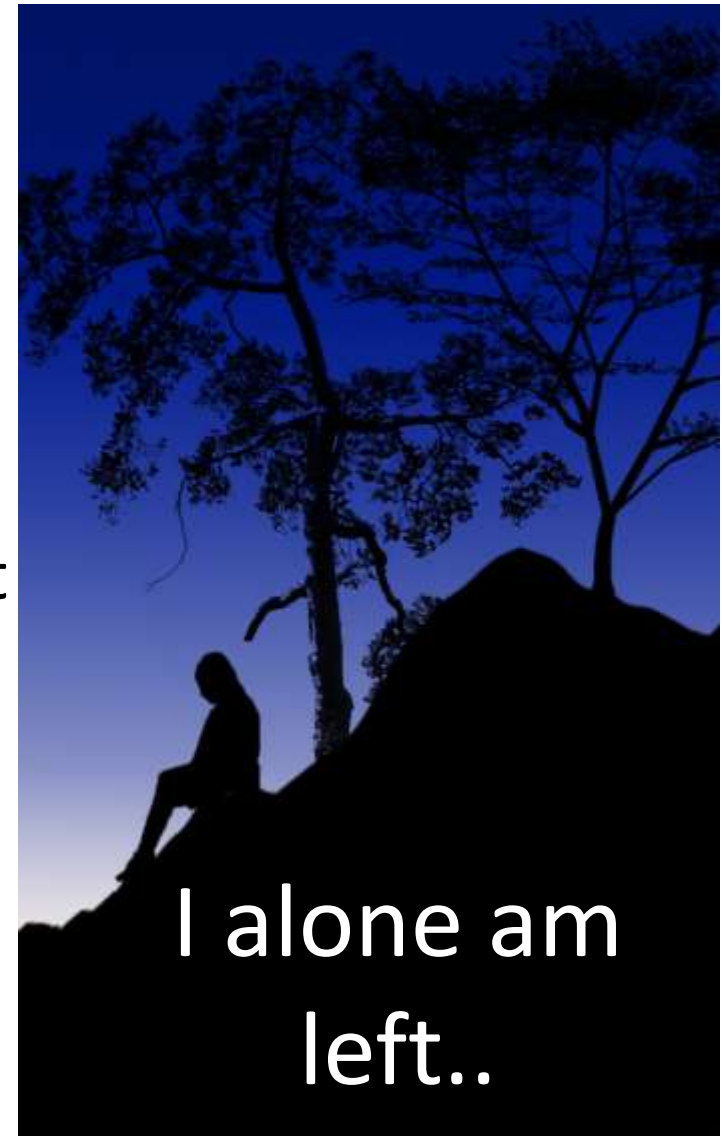

³ And when he saw *that*, he arose and **ran for his life**, and went to Beersheba, which *belongs* to Judah, and left his servant there.

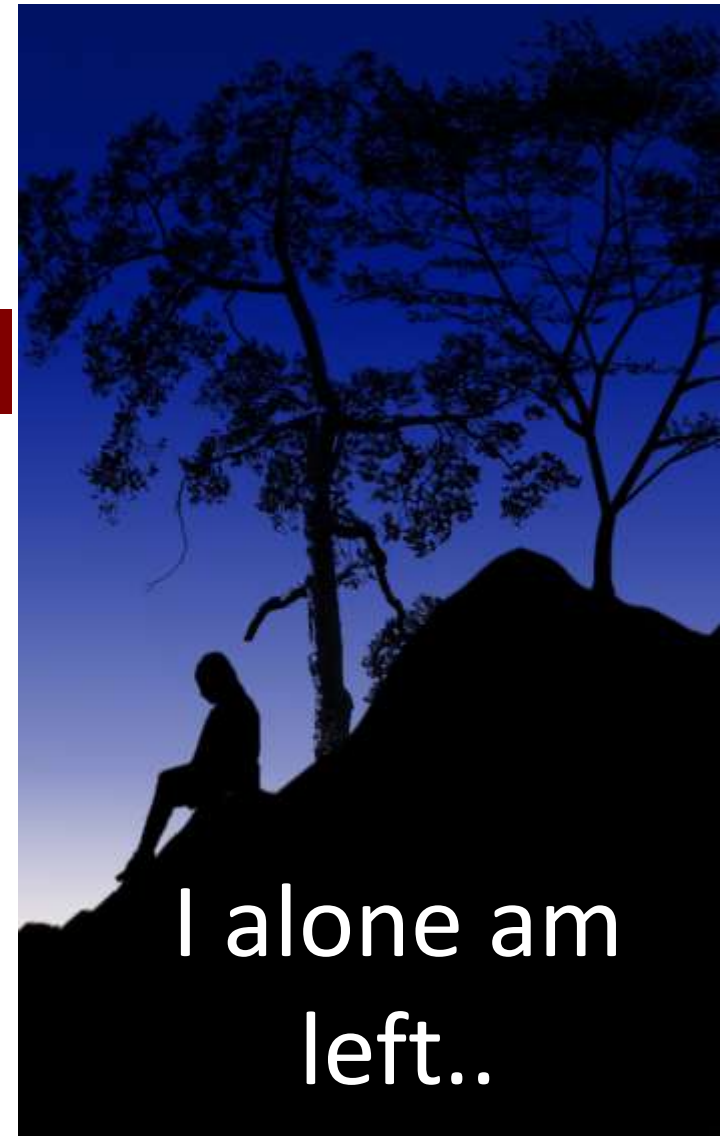
