

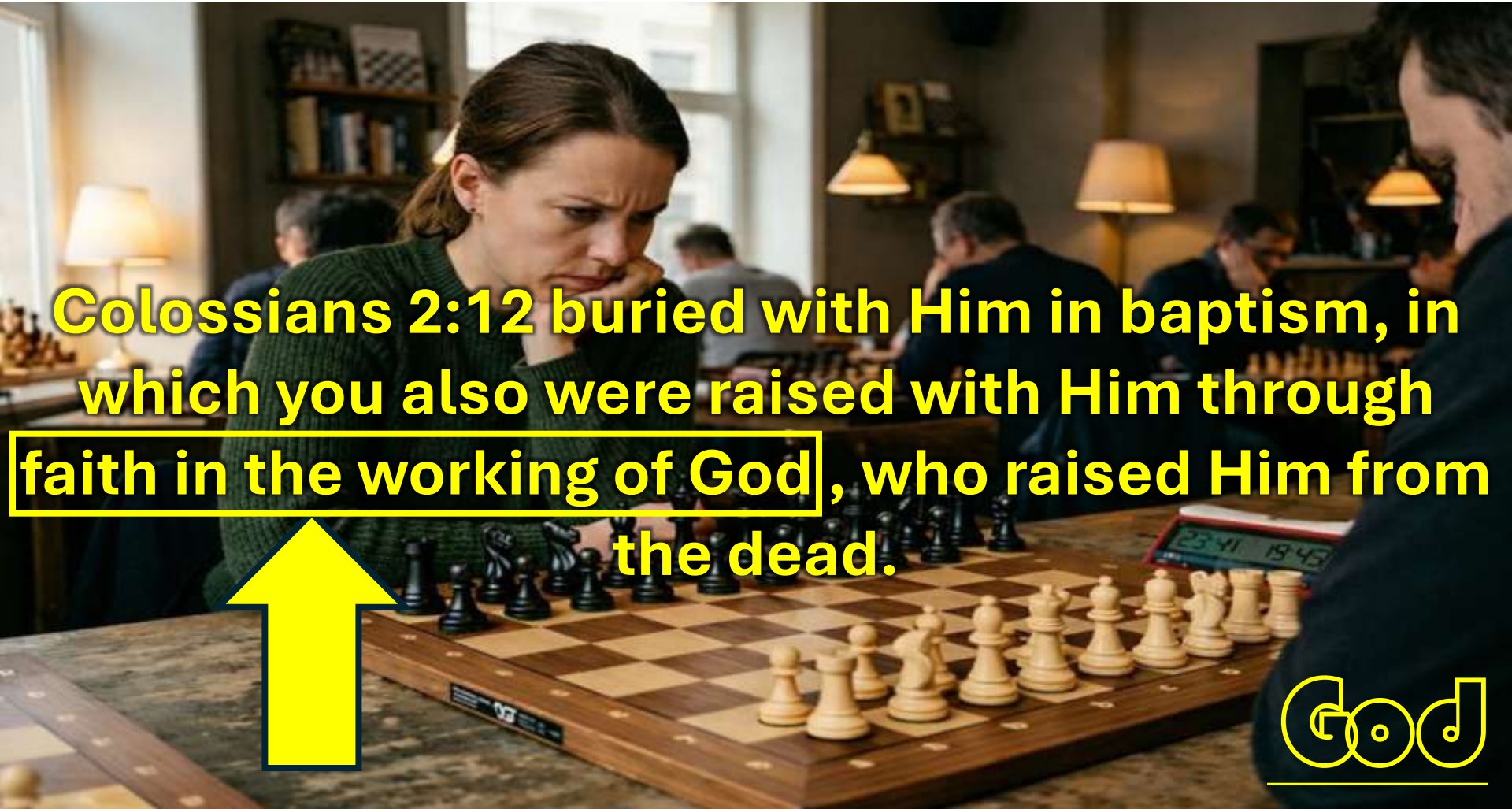
It Is Personal (NKJV)


