



Not Even A "good" Conscience (NKIV)

Acts 22:3-4

- ³ "I am indeed a Jew, born in Tarsus of Cilicia, but brought up in this city at the feet of Gamaliel, taught according to the strictness of our fathers' law, and was zealous toward God as you all are today.
- ⁴I persecuted this Way to the death, binding and delivering into prisons both men and women,
- Acts 22:16 And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.'

Not Even A "good" Conscience (NKIV)

Hebrews 10:22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

- 1 Corinthians 8:12 But when you thus sin against the brethren, and wound their weak conscience, you sin against Christ.
- 1 Timothy 4:2 speaking lies in hypocrisy, having their own conscience seared with a hot iron,
- Titus 1:15 To the pure all things are pure, but to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled.

A GOOD Conscience (NK/V)

1 Timothy 1:4–5⁴ nor give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which cause disputes rather than godly edification which is in faith. 5 Now the purpose of the commandment

(vs 3 ..teach no other doctrine,)

is love from a pure heart, from a good conscience, and from sincere faith,

1 Peter 3:21 There is also an antitype which now saves us—baptism

(Mark 16:16 He who believes and is

baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.)

(not the removal of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God), through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,
