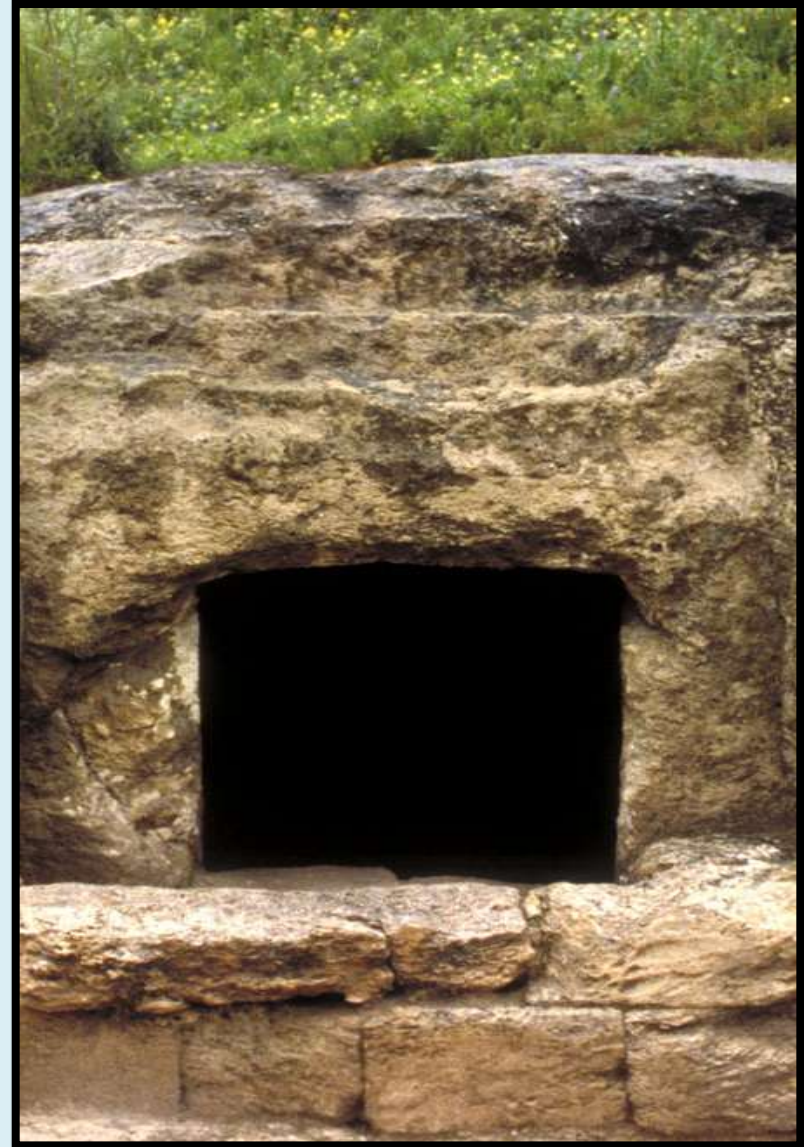


SAW AND BELIEVED FOR AS YET THEY DID NOT KNOW THE SCRIPTURE

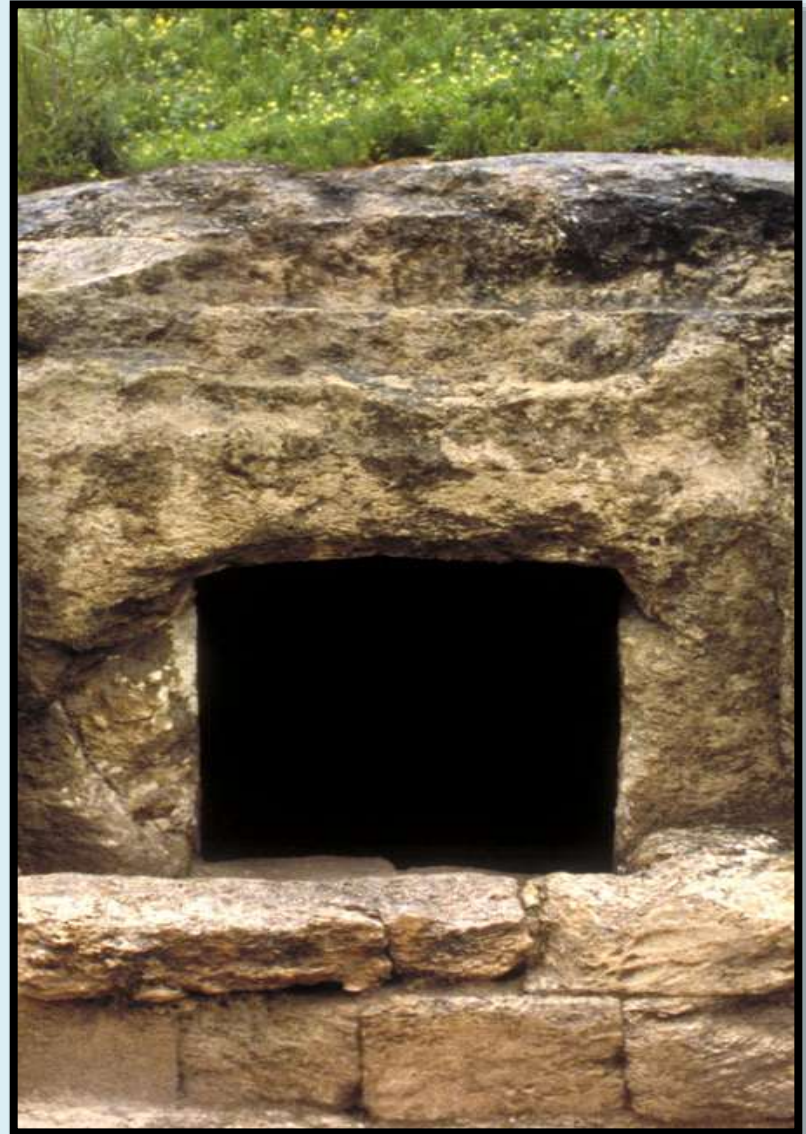

John 20:5-6, 8-9

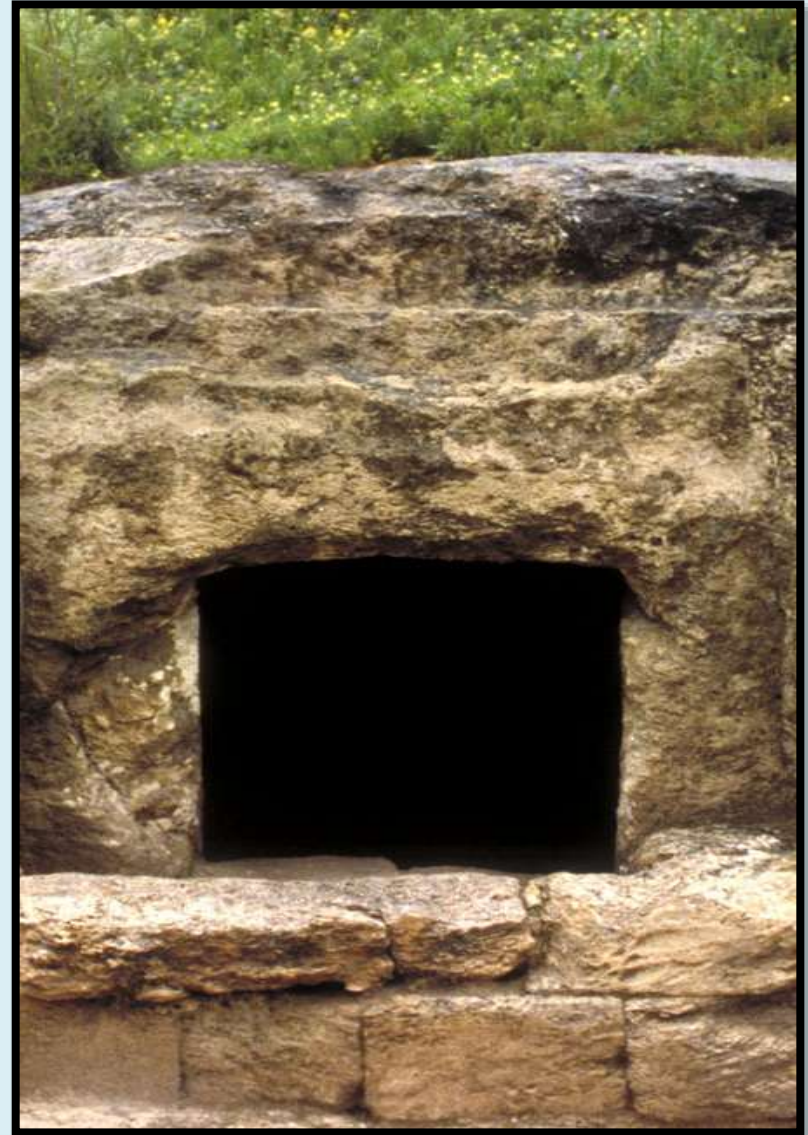
⁵ And he, stooping down and looking in, **saw** the linen cloths lying there; yet he did not go in. ⁶ Then Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the tomb; and he **saw** the linen cloths lying there, ⁸ Then the other disciple, who came to the tomb first, went in also; and **he saw and believed.** ⁹ For **as yet they did not know the Scripture,** that He must rise again from the **dead.**



Matthew 16:21 (*in the region of Caesarea Phillipi*) From that time Jesus began to show to His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day.



Matthew 17:22–23 (*while staying in Galilee*) Now while they were staying in Galilee, Jesus said to them, **“The Son of Man is about to be betrayed into the hands of men, ²³ and they will kill Him, and the third day He will be raised up.”** And they were exceedingly sorrowful.

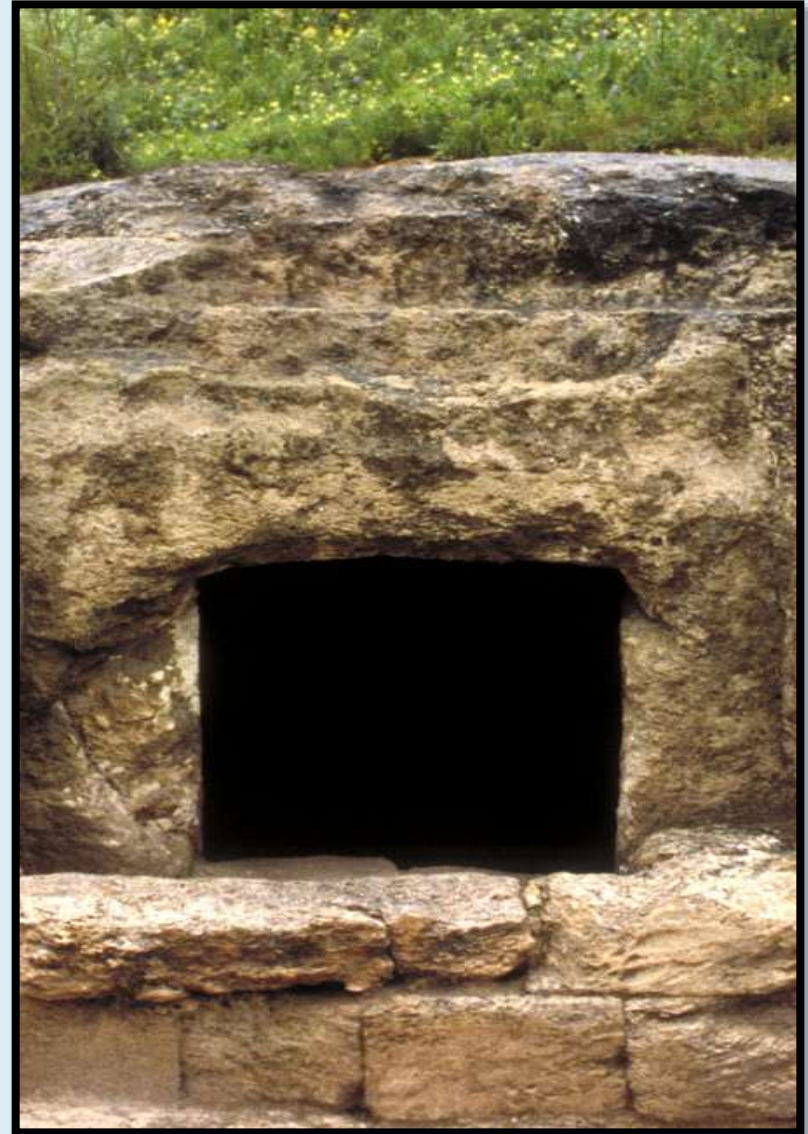


Matthew 20:18–19 (*going up to Jerusalem*)

18 “Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and to the scribes; and they will condemn Him to death,

19 and deliver Him to the Gentiles to mock and to scourge and to crucify.

And the third day He will rise again.”

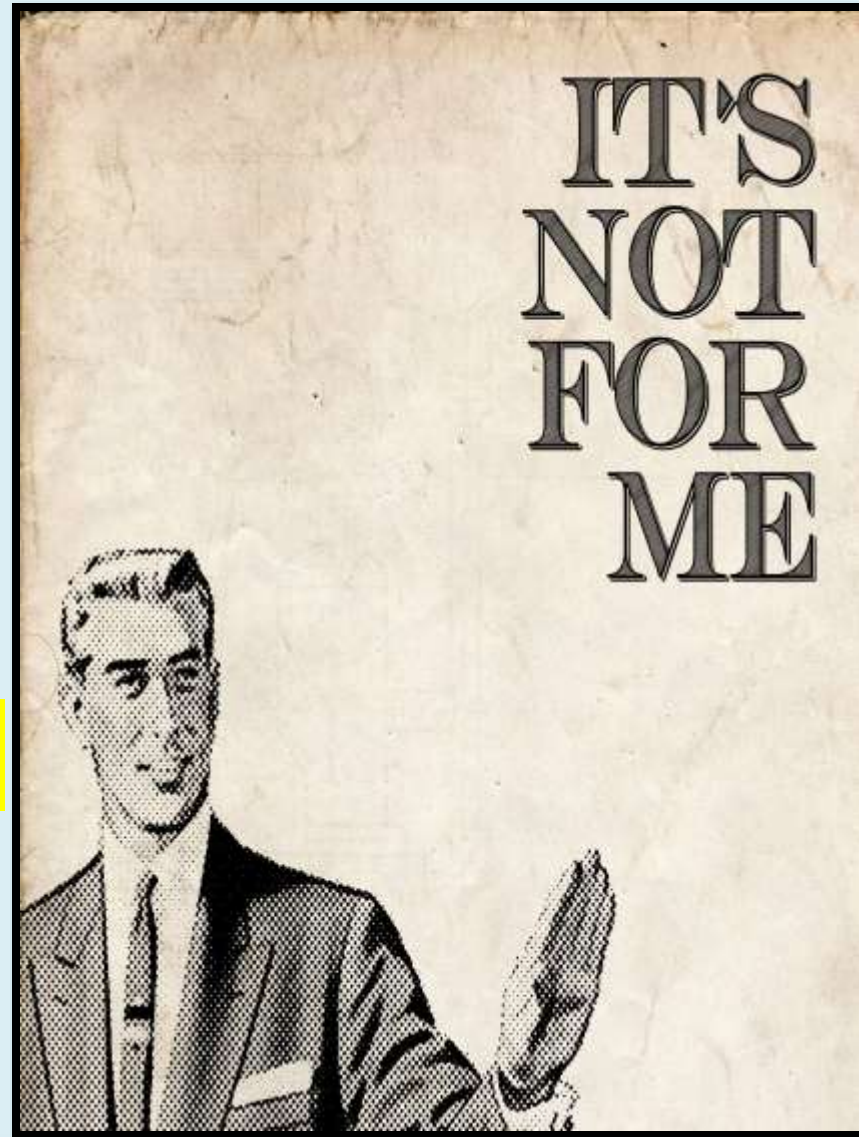
²⁰ When He had said this, He **showed** them His hands and His side. Then **the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord.**

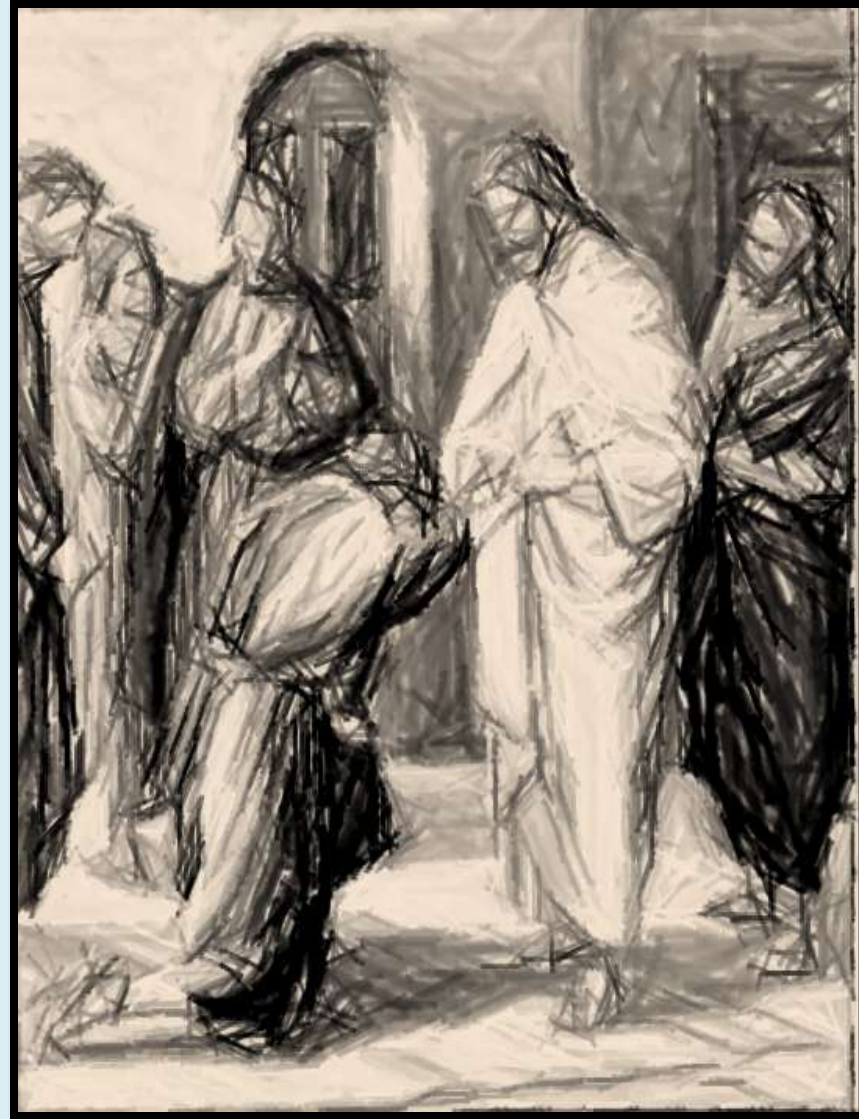

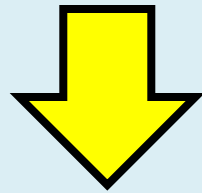

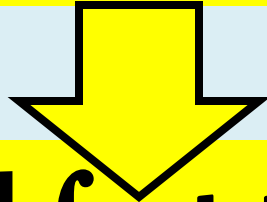

our song shall rise to Thee;**


