

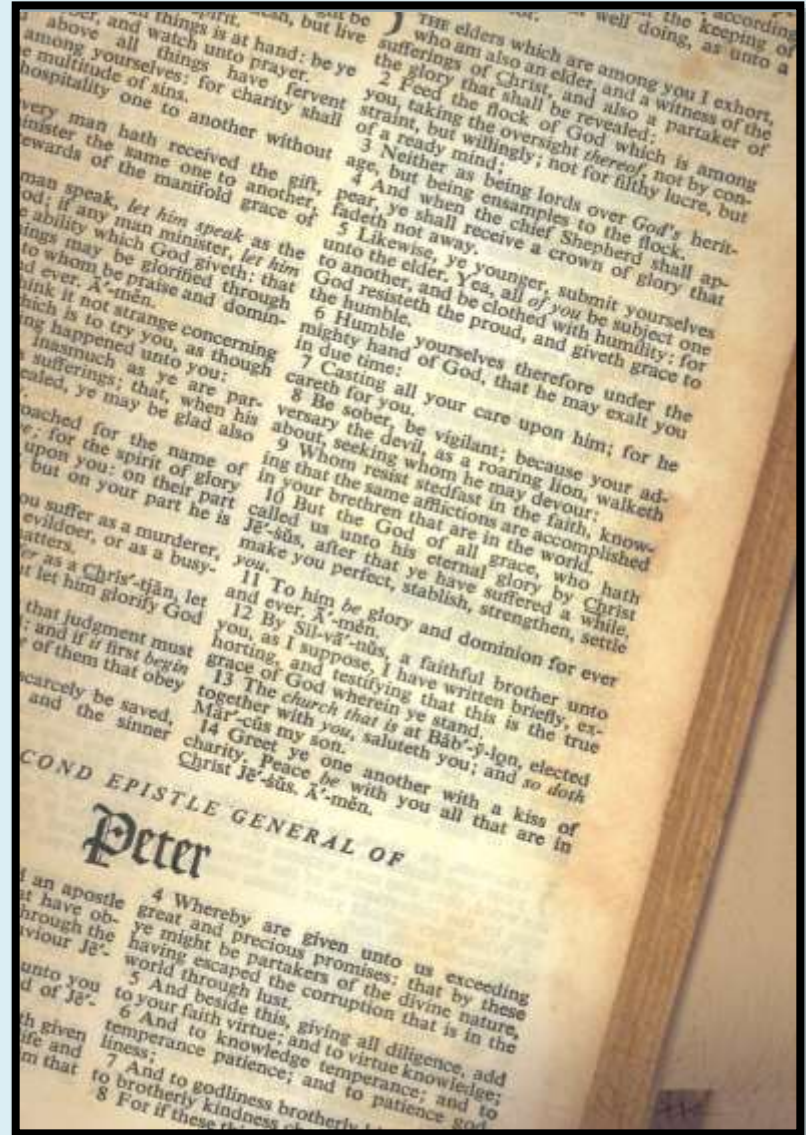

HIS MAJESTY (NKJV)

2 Peter 1:16–18 ¹⁶ For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our **Lord Jesus Christ**, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty. ¹⁷ For He received from **God the Father honor and glory** when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: **“This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.”** ¹⁸ And we heard this voice which came from heaven when we were with Him on the holy mountain.

EXCEEDINGLY WHITE, LIKE SNOW (NKJV)

Mark 9:3 His clothes became shining, exceedingly white, like snow, such as no launderer on earth can whiten them.

Matthew 17:2 ..His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light.

Luke 9:29 ..His face was altered, and His robe became white and glistening.



EXCEEDINGLY WHITE, LIKE SNOW (NKJV)

Revelation 1:14–16 ¹⁴ His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire; ¹⁵ His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and His voice as the sound of many waters; ¹⁶ ..His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength.

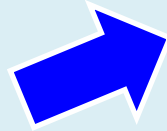

³⁷ Then Philip said, “If you believe with all your heart, you may.” And he answered and said, “I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.”

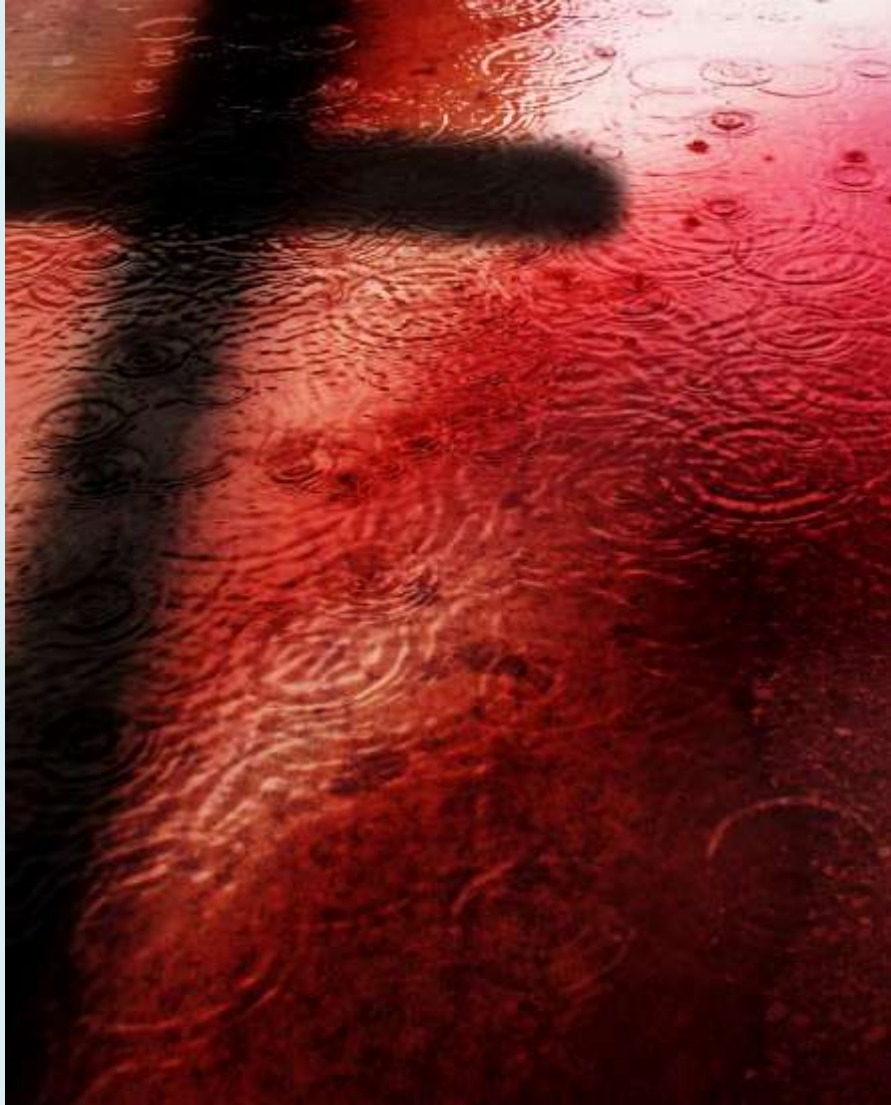

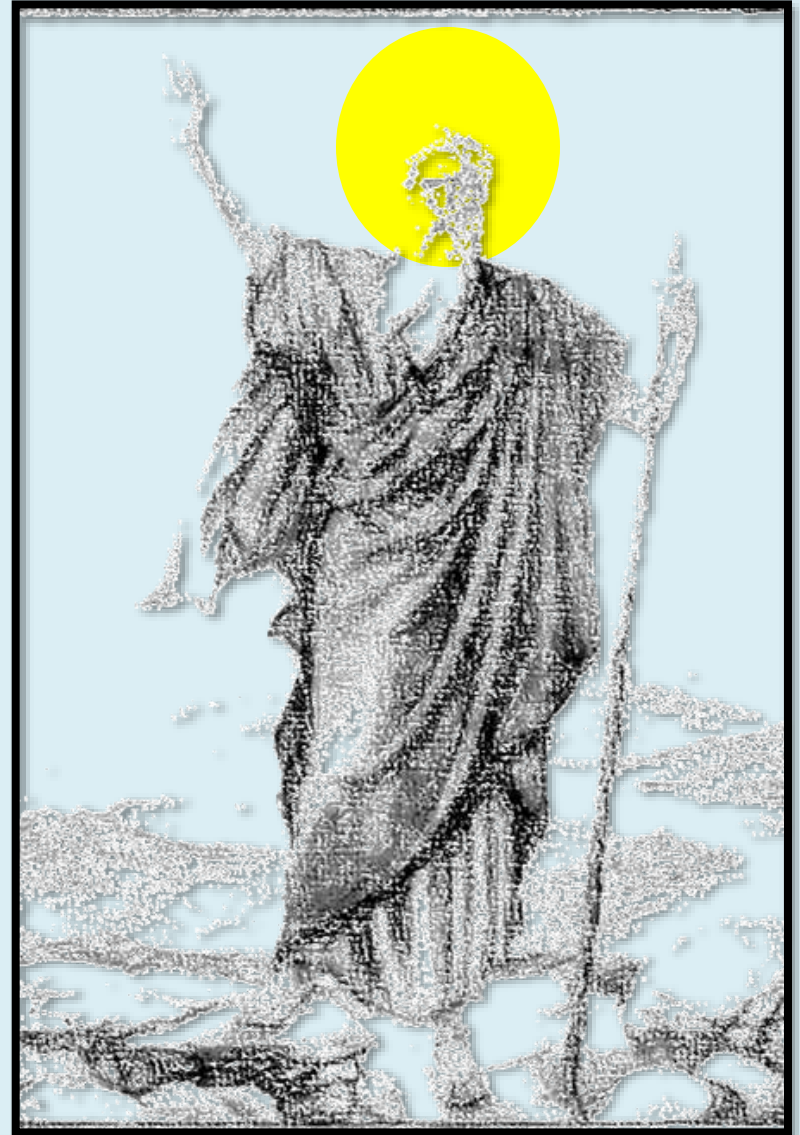

our song shall rise to Thee;**


**Holy, holy, holy! merciful and mighty!
