

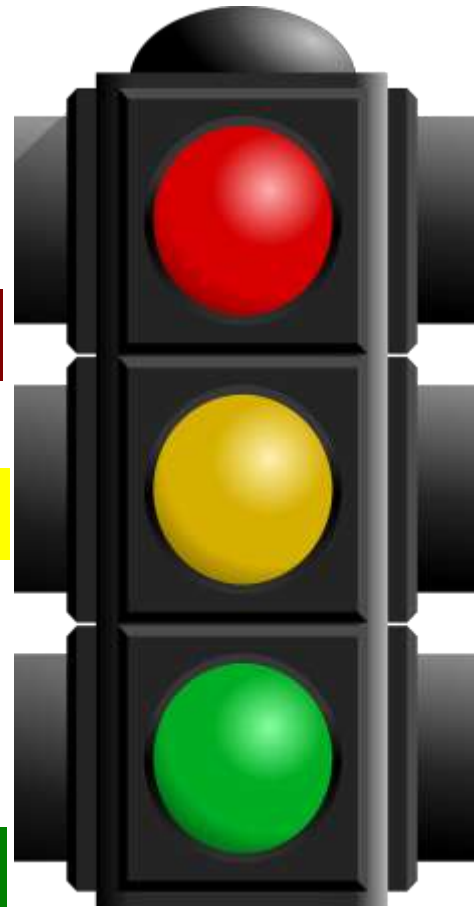

**Matthew 7:21–25** <sup>22</sup> Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’ <sup>23</sup> And then I will declare to them, ‘**I never knew you**; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’

<sup>24</sup> “Therefore **whoever** hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the **rock**: <sup>25</sup> and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was **founded on the rock.**

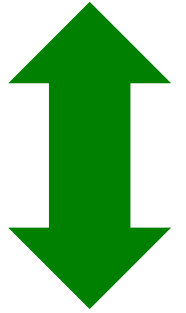
<sup>10</sup> Likewise, I say to you, **there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.**”

<sup>8</sup> If I ascend into heaven,  
**You are there**; If I make my bed in hell (*sheol*,  
*hades*), behold, **You are there.**

<sup>9</sup> If I take the wings of the morning, And dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea,

<sup>10</sup> **Even there** Your hand shall lead me, And **Your right hand shall hold me.**

<sup>11</sup> If I say, “Surely the darkness shall fall on me,”  
Even **the night shall be light about me;**



## **Romans 8:26–27**

**<sup>26</sup> Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.**

**<sup>27</sup> Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.**

# To Be KNOWN By God Is To KNOW Him (NKJV)

## 1 John 2:3–6

<sup>3</sup> Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments.

<sup>4</sup> He who says, “I know Him,” and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

<sup>5</sup> But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him.

<sup>6</sup> He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.
