

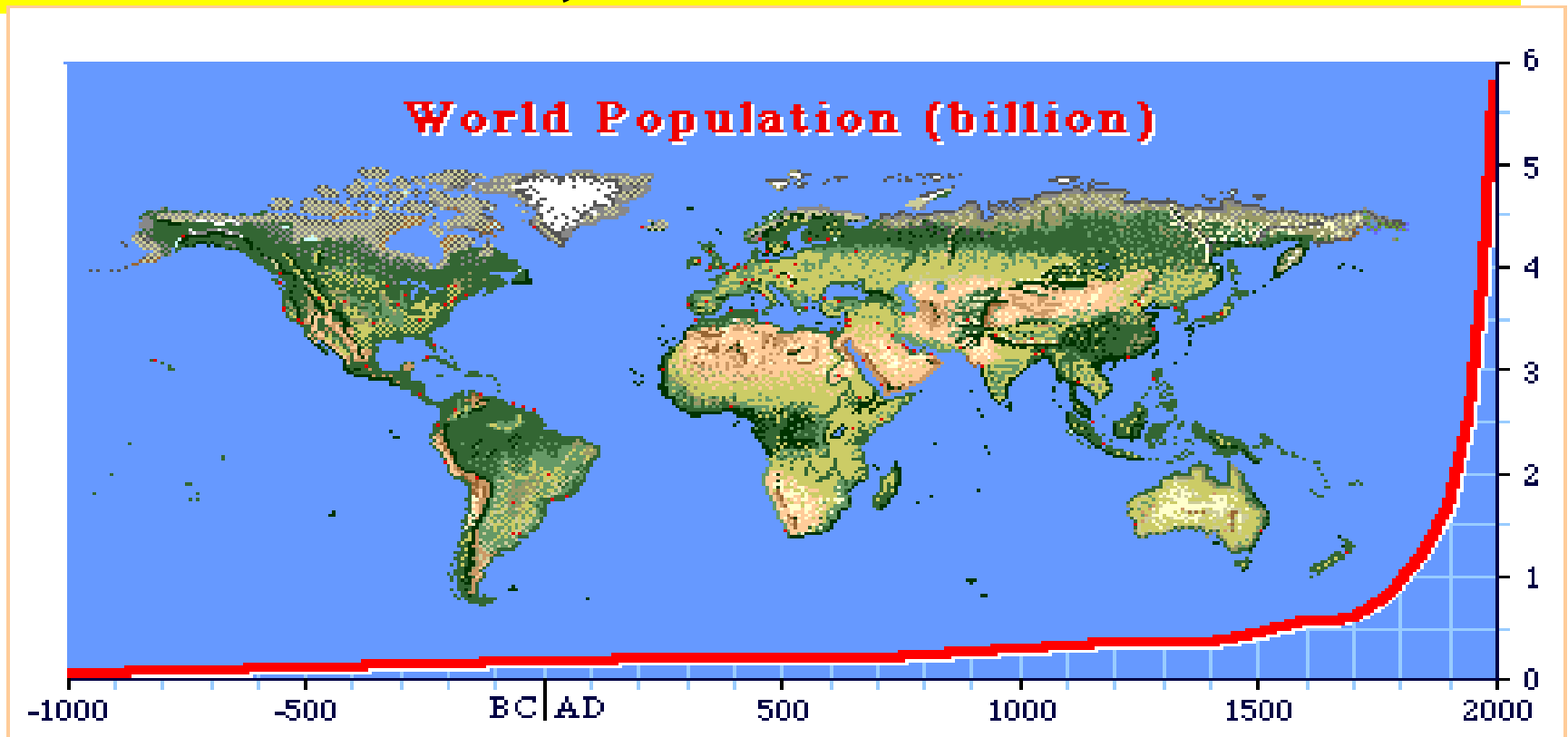

**<sup>39</sup> and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.**

**Luke 17:26–27**

**<sup>26</sup> And as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man:**

**<sup>27</sup> They ate, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all.**

**Corresponding to that, baptism now saves you** (NKJV)

**1 Peter 3:20–21**

<sup>20</sup> who formerly were **disobedient**, when **once the Divine longsuffering** waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, **eight souls**, were saved through water.

<sup>21</sup> **There is also an antitype which now saves us—baptism** (not the removal of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God), through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,

**1 Peter 3:21** ***Corresponding to that, baptism now saves you..***


