

Seeing God, (*Moses*) (NKJV)

Exodus 3:4–6 ⁴ So when the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, “Moses, Moses!” And he said, “Here I am.” ⁵ Then He said, “(1) **Do not draw near this place.** (2) **Take your sandals off your feet,** for the place (3) **where you stand is holy ground.**” ⁶ Moreover He said, “I **am** the God of your father—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.” And **Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon God.**

Seeing God, (*Peter, James, and John*) *(NKJV)*

Mark 9:2–4

² Now after six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John, and led them up on a high mountain apart by themselves; and He was transfigured before them.

³ His clothes became shining, exceedingly white, like snow, such as no launderer on earth can whiten them.

⁴ And Elijah appeared to them with Moses, and they were talking with Jesus.

Mark 9:5–6

⁵ Then Peter answered and said to Jesus, “Rabbi, it is good for us to be here; and let us make three tabernacles: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah”—
⁶ because he did not know what to say, for they were greatly afraid.

Seeing God, (*Isaiah*) *(NKJV)*

Isaiah 6:1–4 ¹ In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple.

² Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. ³ And one cried to another and said: “Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!” ⁴ And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke.
