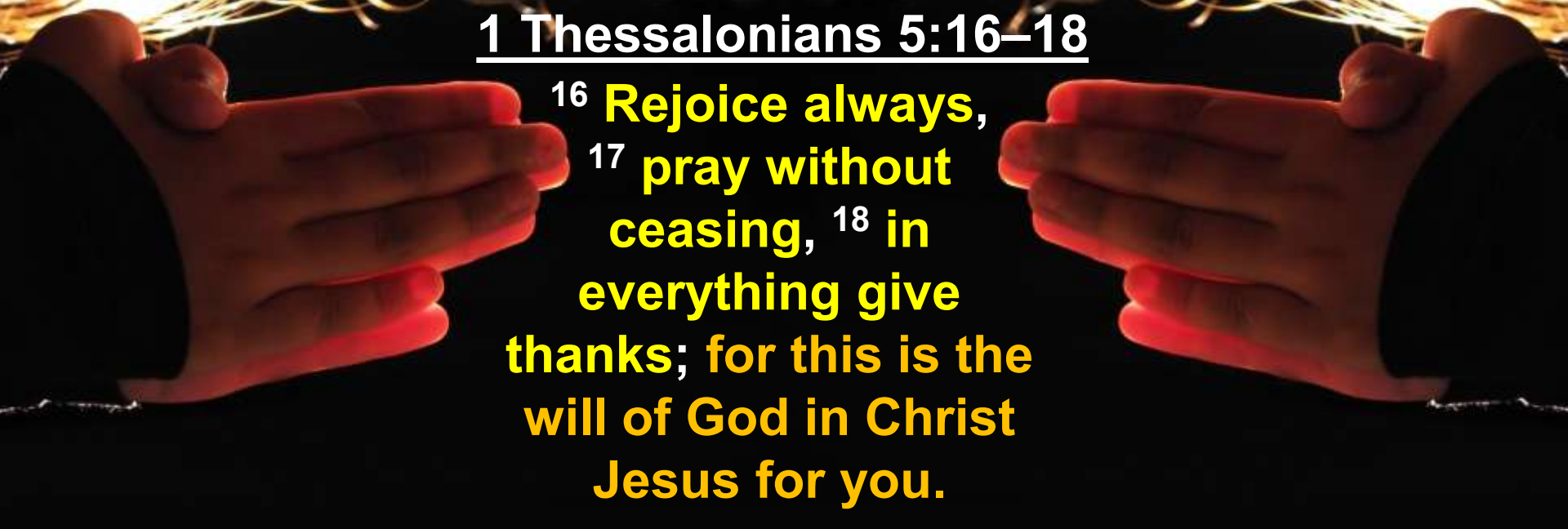

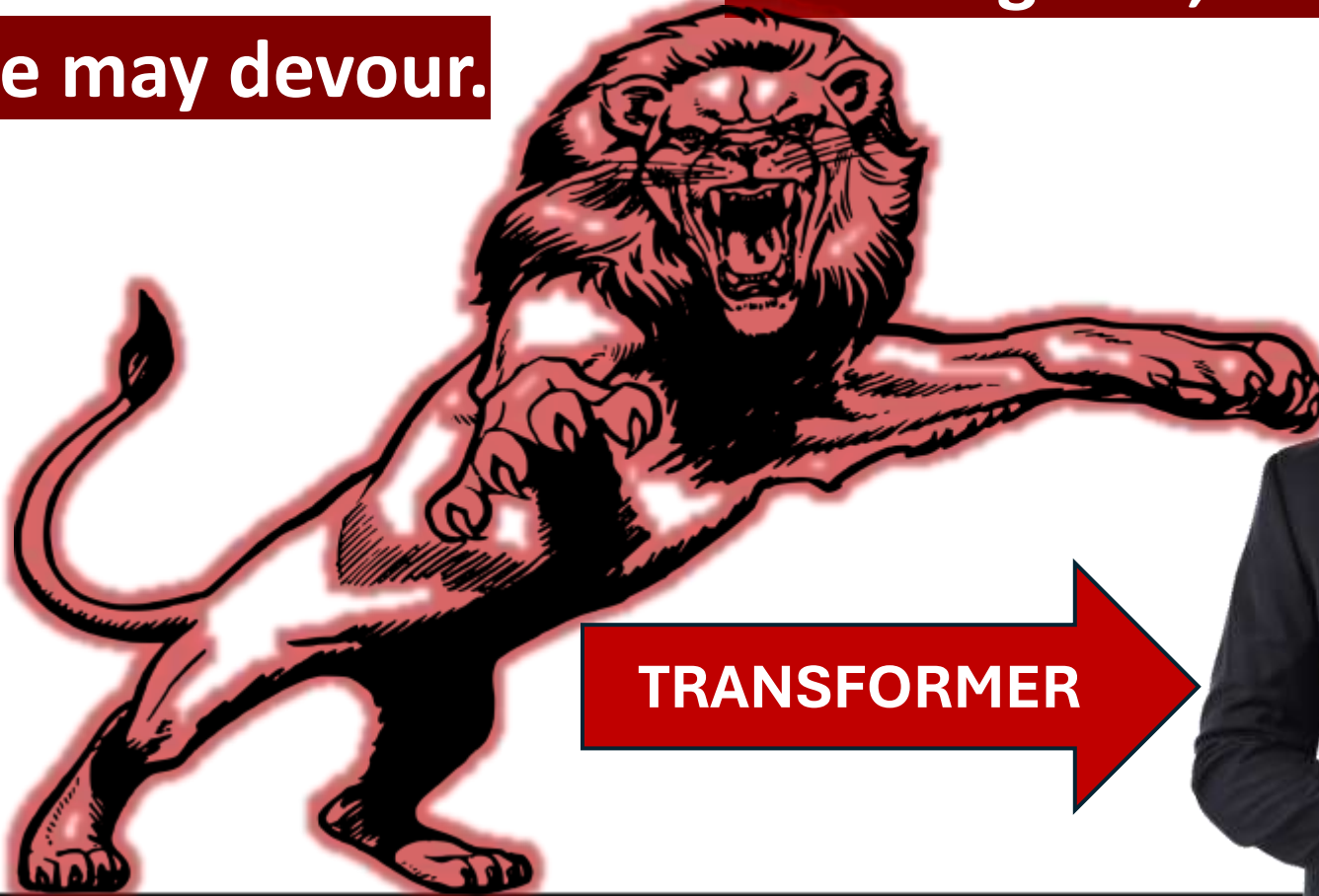


False, deceitful, transforming, roaring lion seeking to devour

Be sober, be vigilant; because **your adversary** the devil walks about like **a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.**

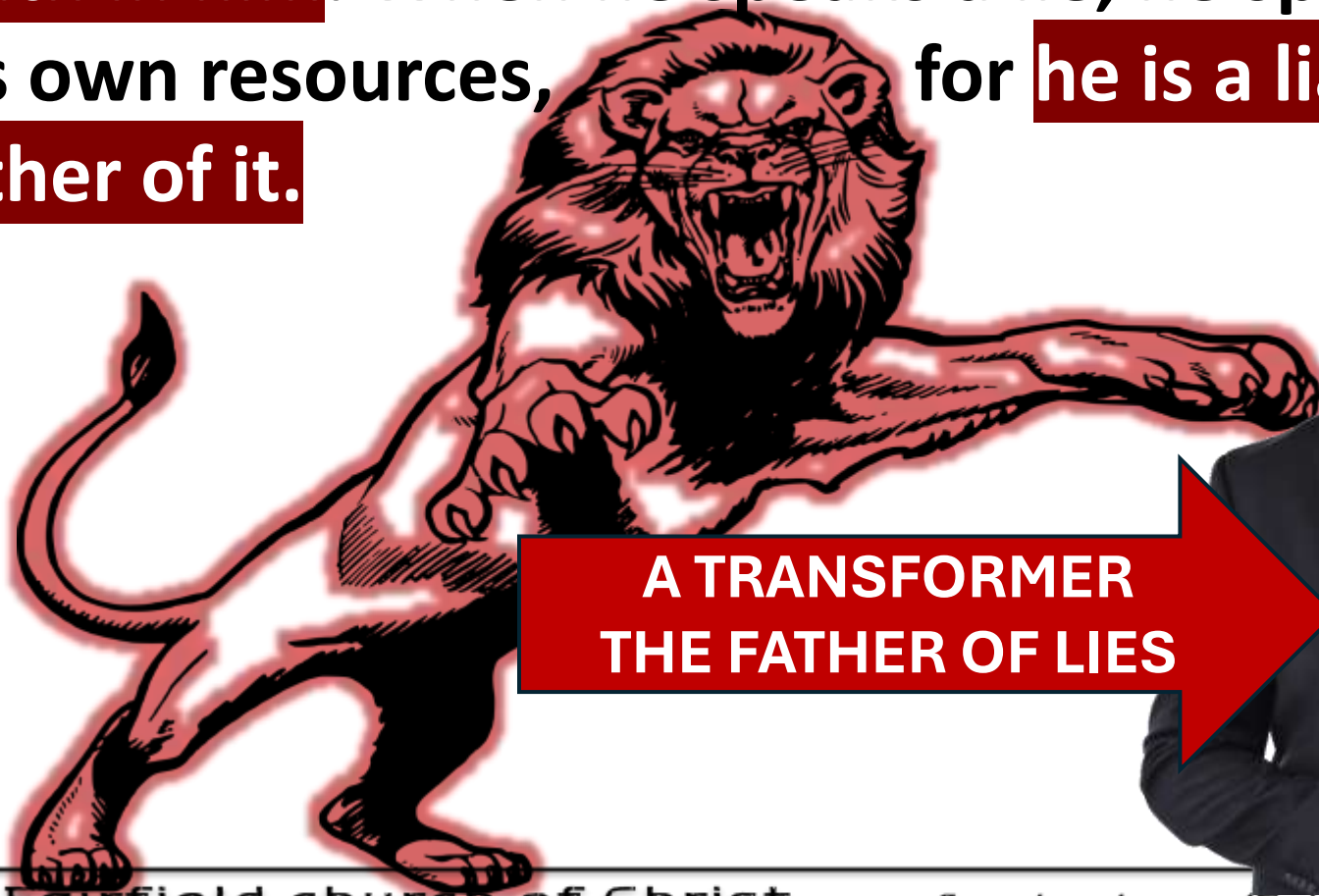

THE FATHER OF LIES**

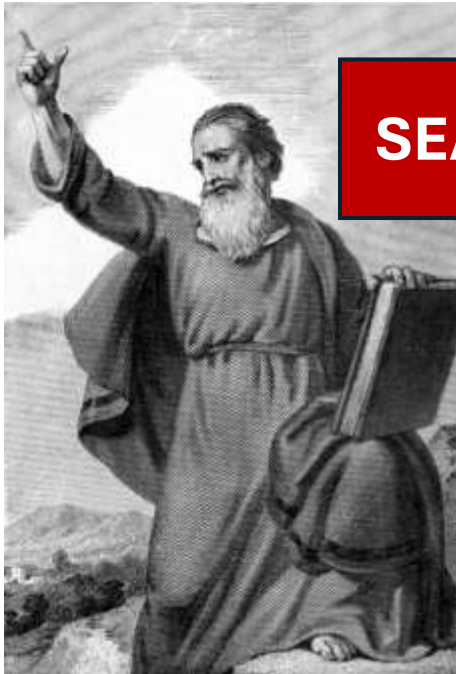


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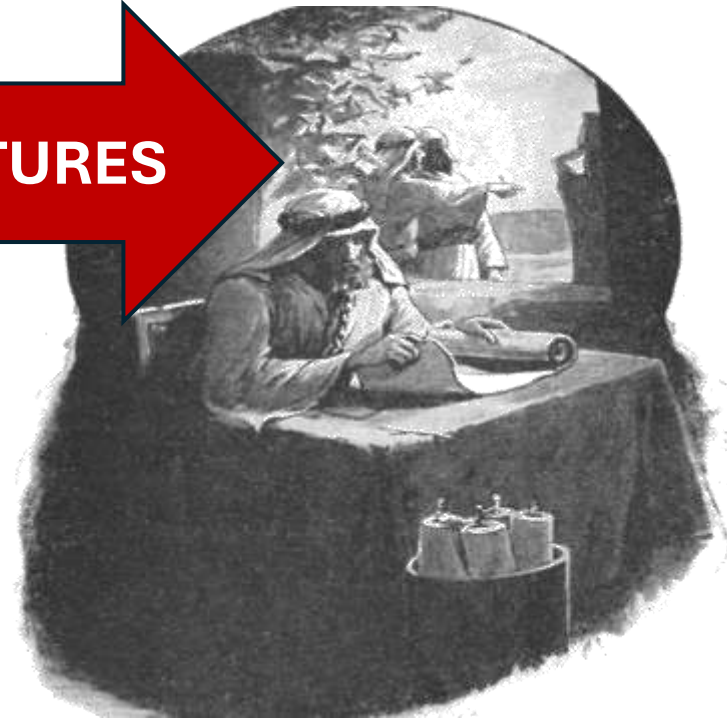
