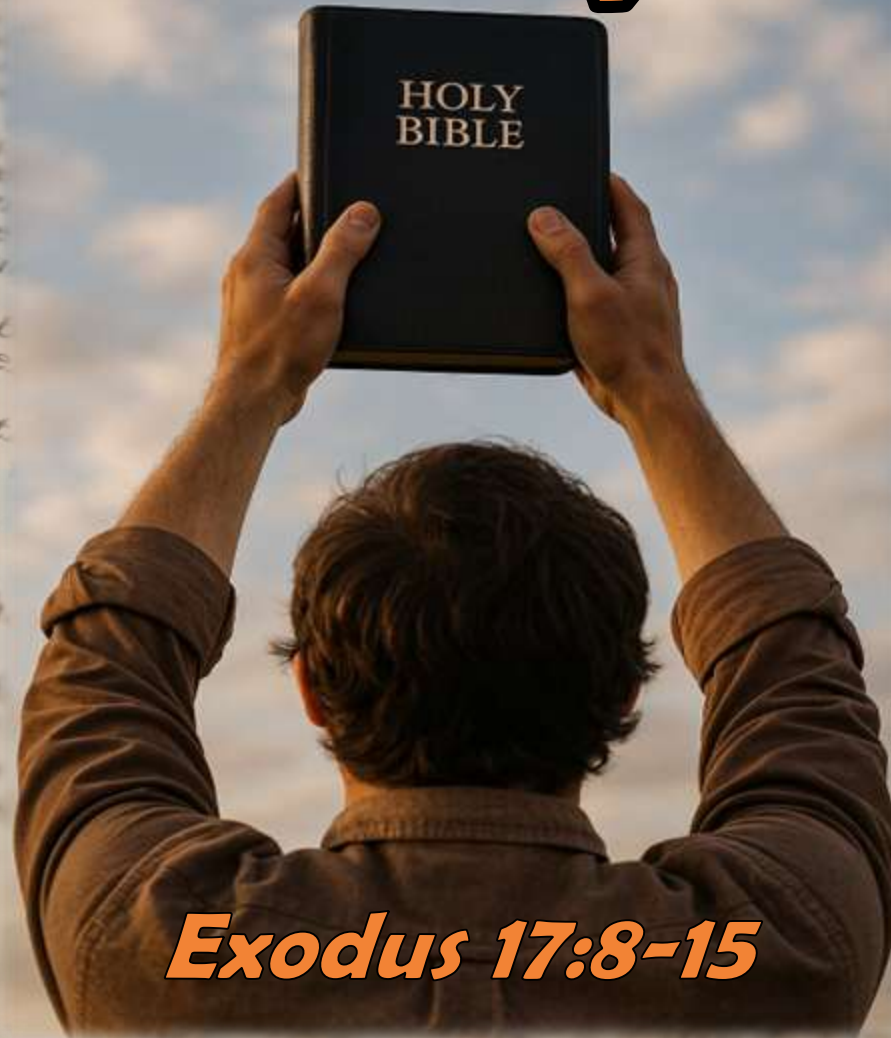



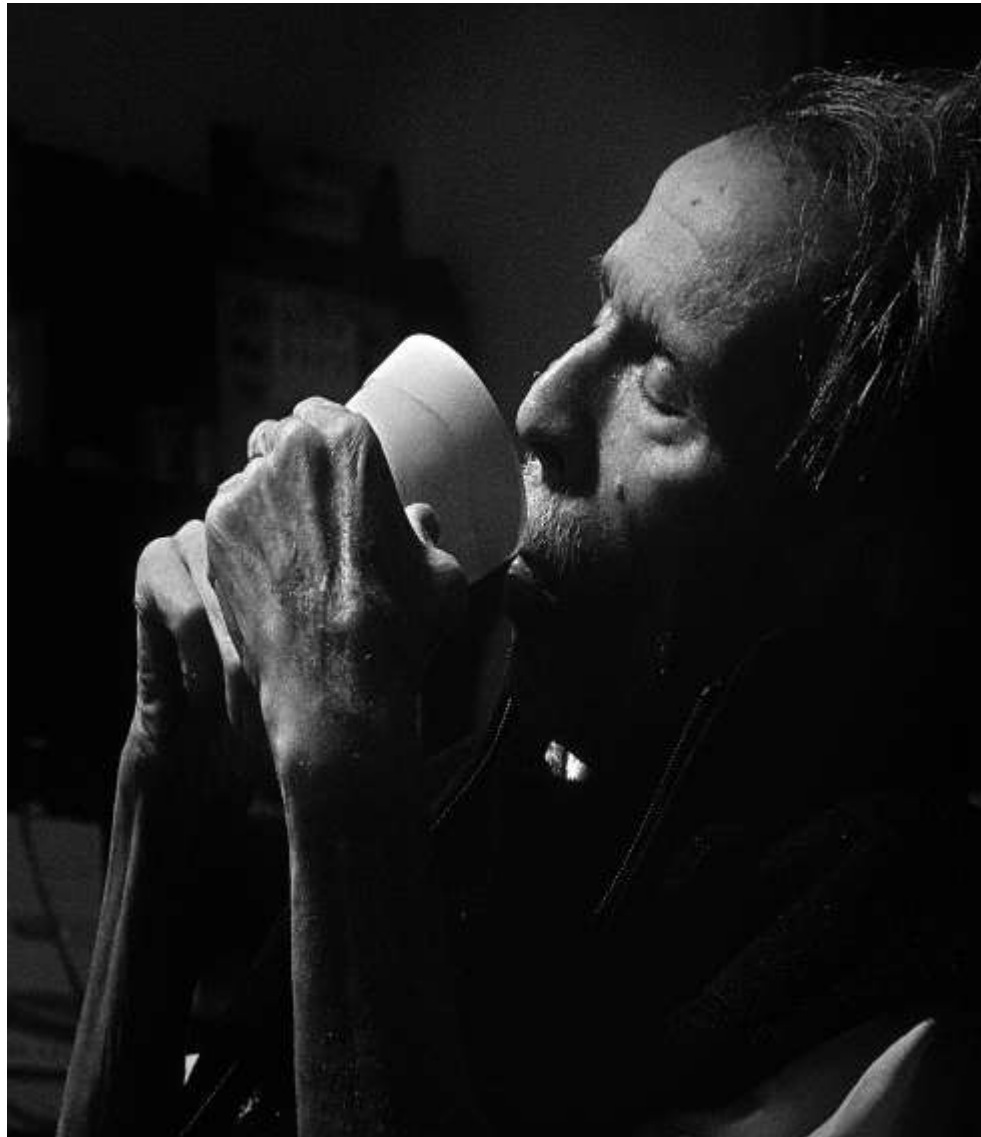

go out, fight (NKJV)

Exodus 17:8–9

⁸ Now Amalek came and fought with Israel in Rephidim.

⁹ And Moses said to Joshua, “Choose us some men and go out, **fight** with Amalek. Tomorrow I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in my hand.”

1 Corinthians 9:26
