



Matt. 15:19 ..out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies.







(vs 7.. the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin)




The Human Heart (NKJV)

The Vital Function of the Human Heart

The heart's primary function is to pump blood throughout the body, delivering **oxygen** and **nutrients** to cells and tissues. It also **removes carbon dioxide and waste products** from the body.




