(NKJV)

### Mark 14:55–59

<sup>55</sup> Now the chief priests and all the council sought testimony against Jesus to put Him to death, but found none.

<sup>56</sup> For many bore false witness against Him, but their testimonies did not agree. <sup>57</sup> Then some rose up and bore

false witness against Him, saying,

<sup>58</sup> “We heard Him say, ‘I will destroy this temple made with hands, and within three days I will build another made without hands.’ ”

<sup>59</sup> But not even then did their testimony agree.



## the high priest tore his clothes

(NKJV)

Mark 14:60–63 <sup>60</sup> And the high priest stood up in the midst and asked Jesus, saying, “Do You answer nothing? What is it these men testify against You?” <sup>61</sup>

But He kept silent and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked Him, saying to Him, “Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?” <sup>62</sup>

Jesus said, “I am. And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven.” <sup>63</sup> Then the high priest tore his clothes and said, “What further need do we have of witnesses?”



# The high priest shall not tear his clothes

(NKJV)

Leviticus 10:6 And Moses said to Aaron, and to Eleazar and Ithamar, his sons, "Do not uncover your heads **nor tear your clothes**, lest you die, and wrath come upon all the people. But let your brethren, the whole house of Israel, bewail the burning which the Lord has kindled.

Leviticus 21:10 **'He who is the high priest** among his brethren, on whose head the anointing oil was poured and who is consecrated to wear the garments, shall not uncover his head **nor tear his clothes;**



**they all condemned Jesus to be deserving of death**

(NKJV)

Mark 14:63–65

<sup>63</sup> Then the high priest tore his clothes and said, “What further need do we have of witnesses?”

<sup>64</sup> You have heard the blasphemy! What do you think?” And they all condemned Him to be deserving of death.

<sup>65</sup> Then some began to spit on Him, and to blindfold Him, and to beat Him, and to say to Him, “Prophecy!” And the officers struck Him with the palms of their hands.



# Let us not tear it (NKJV)

## John 19:23-24

<sup>23</sup> Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts, to each soldier a part, and also the tunic. Now the tunic was without seam, woven from the top in one piece.

<sup>24</sup> They said therefore among themselves, "**Let us not tear it**, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be," that the Scripture might be fulfilled which says: "They divided My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots." Therefore the soldiers did these things.


