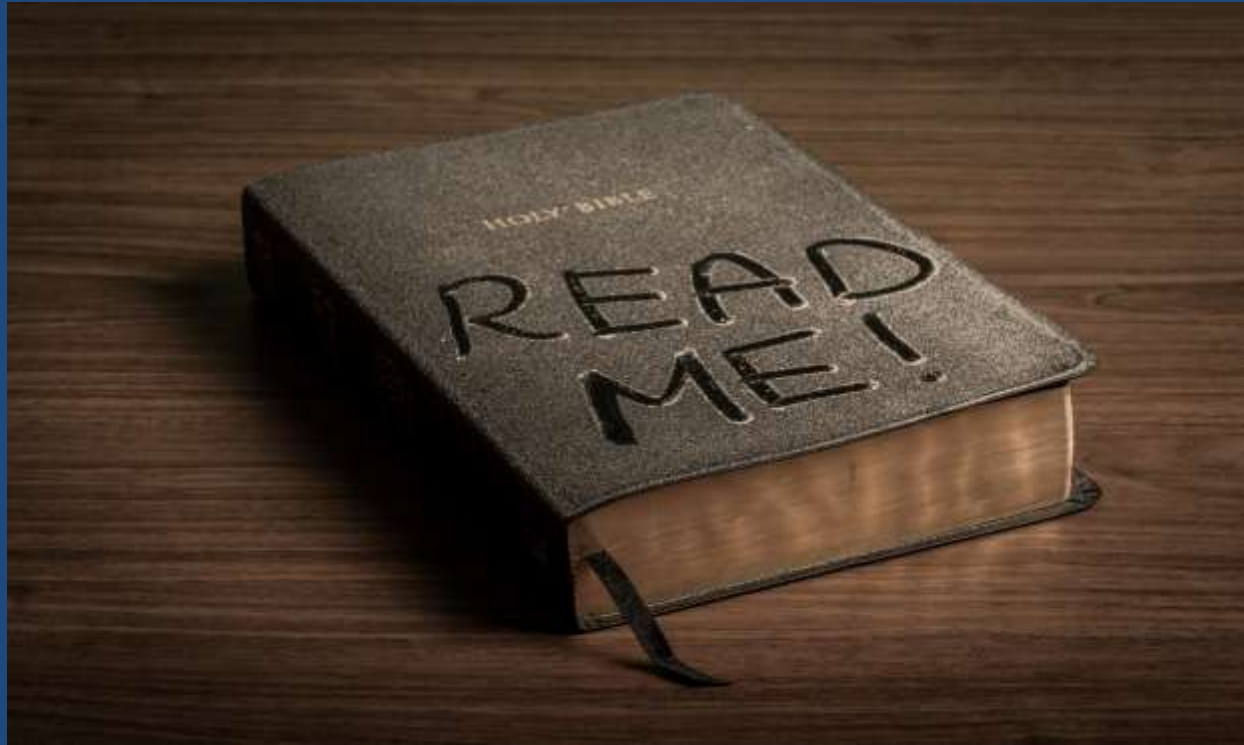



2 Kings 18:2-6 (NKJV) ² He was twenty-five years old when he became king, and **he reigned twenty-nine years** in Jerusalem..³ And **he did *what was right in the sight of the LORD***, according to all that his father David had done. ⁵ **He trusted in the LORD God of Israel, so that after him was none like him among all the kings of Judah, nor who were before him.** ⁶ **For he held fast to the LORD; he did not depart from following Him, but kept His commandments, which the LORD had commanded Moses.**

2 Kings 21:1-6 (NKJV) ¹ Manasseh was twelve years old when he became king, and **he reigned fifty-five years** in Jerusalem ² And he did evil in the sight of the **LORD**, according to the abominations of the nations whom the LORD had cast out before the children of Israel. ³ For he rebuilt the high places which Hezekiah his father had destroyed; he raised up altars for Baal, and made a wooden image, as Ahab king of Israel had done; and he worshiped all the host of heaven and served them. ⁶ ..He did much evil in the sight of the **LORD**, to provoke *Him* to anger.

¹⁹ Amon was twenty-two years old when he became king, and **he reigned two years** in Jerusalem. ²⁰ And **he did evil in the sight of the LORD, as his father Manasseh had done.** ²¹ So he walked in all the ways that his father had walked; and he served the idols that his father had served, and worshiped them.

2 Chronicles 34:1-7 (NKJV) ¹ **Josiah** was eight years old when he became king, and **he reigned thirty-one years** in Jerusalem.

² And **he did *what was* right in the sight of the LORD**, and walked in the ways of his father David; ***he did not* turn aside to the right hand or to the left.** ³ For **in the eighth year of his reign, while he was still young, he began to seek the God of his father David; and in the twelfth year he began to purge Judah and Jerusalem of the high places, the wooden images, the carved images, and the molded images.**

Josiah; Best intentions & The Lost Book Read

2 Chronicles 34:8 (NKJV) In **the eighteenth year of his reign**, when **he had purged the land and the temple**, he sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, Maaseiah the governor of the city, and Joah the son of Joahaz the recorder, **to repair the house of the LORD his God.**

14 ..Hilkiah the priest found the Book of the Law of the LORD given by Moses. ¹⁸ Then Shaphan the scribe told the king, saying, "Hilkiah the priest has given me a book." And **Shaphan read it before the king.** ¹⁹ Thus it happened, **when the king heard the words of the Law**, that **he tore his clothes.**

Josiah; The Found Book Kept



2 Chronicles 34:30-31 (NKJV) ³⁰ The king went up to the house of the LORD, **with all the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem--the priests and the Levites, and all the people, great and small. And he read in their hearing all the words of the Book of the Covenant** which had been found in the house of the LORD. ³¹ Then **the king stood in his place and made a covenant before the LORD, to follow the LORD, and to keep His commandments and His testimonies and His statutes with all his heart and all his soul, to perform the words of the covenant that were written in this book.**

Josiah; The Found Book Kept

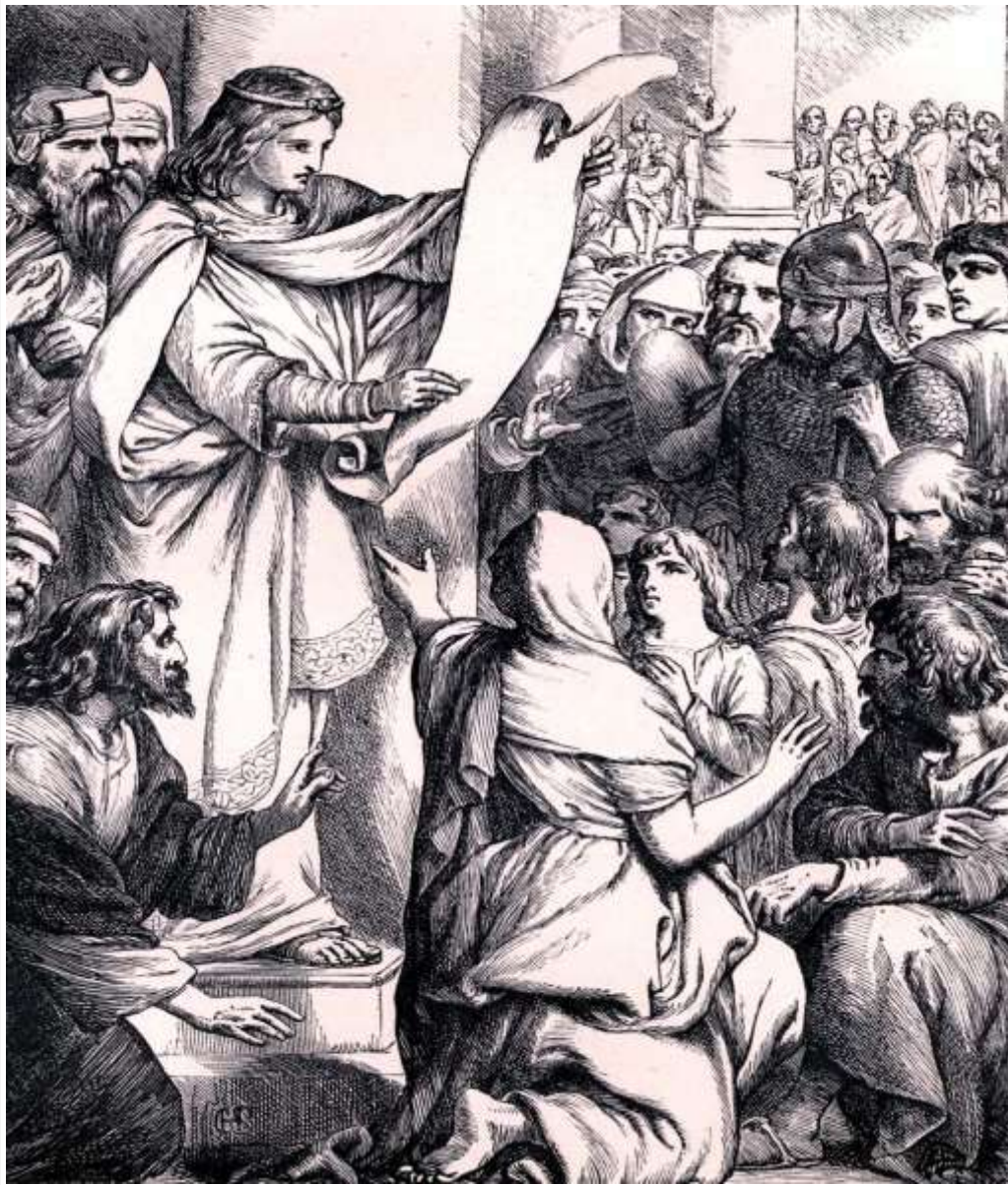
2 Chronicles 34:32-33 (NKJV)

³² And he made all who were present in Jerusalem and Benjamin take a stand. So **the inhabitants of Jerusalem did according to the covenant of God, the God of their fathers.**

³³ **Thus Josiah removed all the abominations from all the country that *belonged* to the children of Israel, and made all who were present in Israel diligently serve the LORD their God. All his days they did not depart from following the LORD God of their fathers.**

2 Kings 23:25 (NKJV)
25 Now before him there was no king like him, who turned to the LORD with all his heart, with all his soul, and with all his might, according to all the Law of Moses; nor after him did any arise like him.

evil in the sight of the Lord- 22 ½ years..

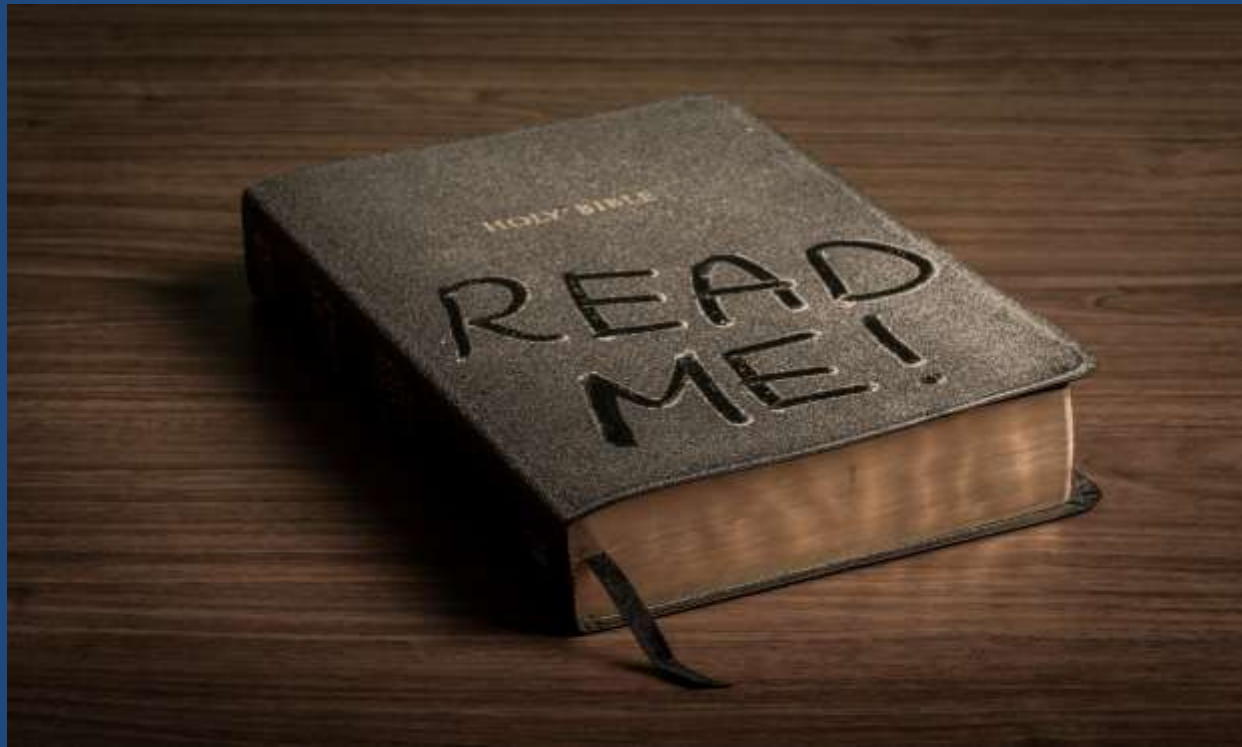
2 Kings 23:31–32 ³¹ **Jehoahaz** was twenty-three years old when he became king, and he reigned **three months** in Jerusalem..³² And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his fathers had done.

2 Kings 23:36–37 ³⁶ **Jehoiakim** was twenty-five years old when he became king, and he reigned **eleven years** in Jerusalem..³⁷ And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his fathers had done.

2 Kings 24:8–9 ⁸ **Jehoiachin** was eighteen years old when he became king, and he reigned in Jerusalem **three months**..⁹ And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father had done.

2 Kings 24:18–19 ¹⁸ **Zedekiah** was twenty-one years old when he became king, and he reigned **eleven years** in Jerusalem..¹⁹ He also did evil in the sight of the LORD, according to all that Jehoiakim had done.


