

¹ Beloved, I now write to you this second epistle (in both of which I stir up your pure minds by way of reminder),

² that you may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets,

and of the commandment of us, the apostles of the Lord and Savior,

be mindful of the words *(NKJV)*

2 Peter 1:12–13 ¹² For this reason I will not be negligent to remind you always of these things, though you know and are established in the present truth. ¹³ Yes, I think it is right, as long as I am in this tent, to stir you up by reminding you,

Where is the promise of His coming? (NKJV)

2 Peter 3:4-7 ⁴ and saying, **“Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of creation.”**

⁵ For this **they willfully forget**: that **by the word of God** the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water, ⁶ by which **the world that then existed perished**, being flooded with water.

⁷ But the heavens and the earth which are now preserved by **the same word**, are reserved for fire until **the day of judgment** and perdition of ungodly men.

10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up.

11 ..all these things will be dissolved, ..

12 ..the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat..


