

She claims that **Muslims, Hindus, Jews, and even atheists have relationships with God that are just as valid as any Christian's.**

xxxxxxxxx, who **leads an LGBTQ support group** during seminary and is

a social justice advocate, said she does not read Jesus's statements as being about "other people of other faiths not getting to God because they don't say the word Jesus."


