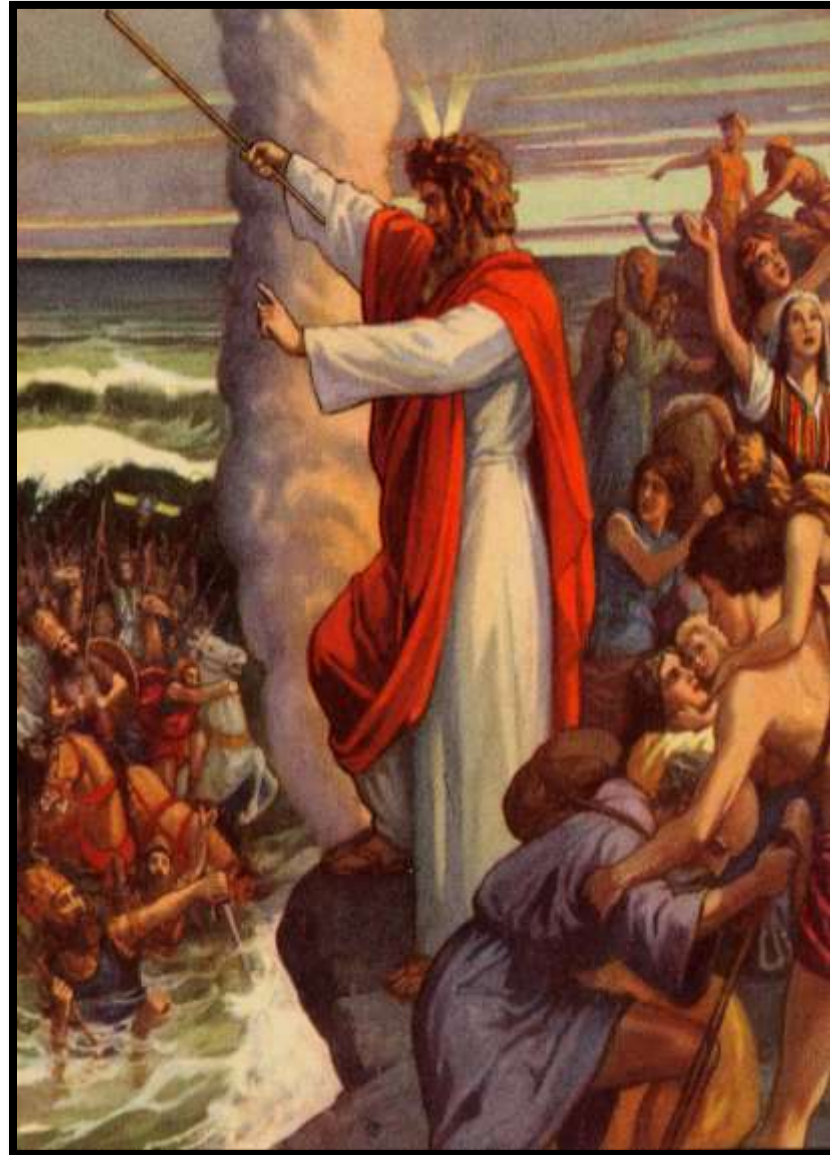
# the people complained against Moses (NKJV)

<sup>23</sup> Now when they came to Marah, they could not drink the waters of Marah, for they were bitter.

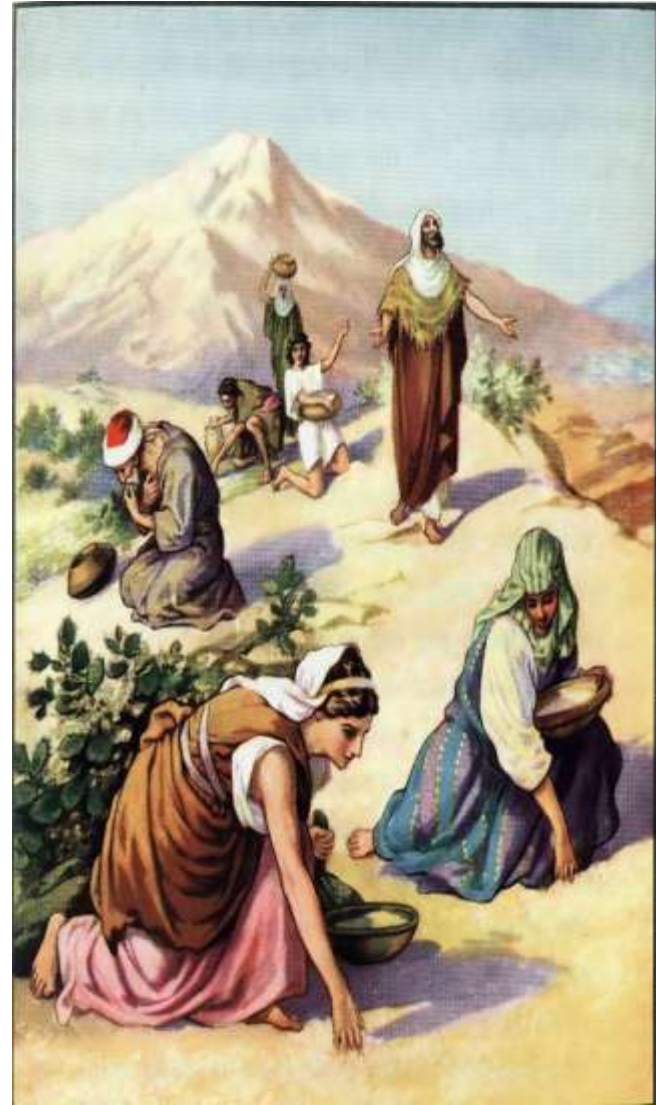
Therefore the name of it was called Marah. <sup>24</sup> And **the people complained against Moses, saying, “What shall we drink?”**

# the people complained against Moses (NKJV)

**Exodus 16:2–4** <sup>2</sup> Then the whole congregation of the children of Israel complained against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness. <sup>3</sup> And the children of Israel said to them, “Oh, that we had died by the hand of the LORD in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the pots of meat and when we ate bread to the full! For you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly with hunger.” <sup>4</sup> Then the LORD said to Moses, “Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you..”



## the people contended with Moses (NKJV)

**Exodus 17:2–6** <sup>2</sup> Therefore the people contended with Moses, and said, “Give us water, that we may drink.” So Moses said to them, “Why do you contend with me? Why do you tempt the LORD?” <sup>3</sup> And the people thirsted there for water, and the people complained against Moses, and said, “Why is it you have brought us up out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and our livestock with thirst?” <sup>4</sup> So Moses cried out to the LORD, saying, “What shall I do with this people? They are almost ready to stone me!” <sup>6</sup> Behold, I will stand before you there on the rock in Horeb; and you shall strike the rock, and water will come out of it..

<sup>14</sup> So the LORD relented from the harm which He said He would do to His people.



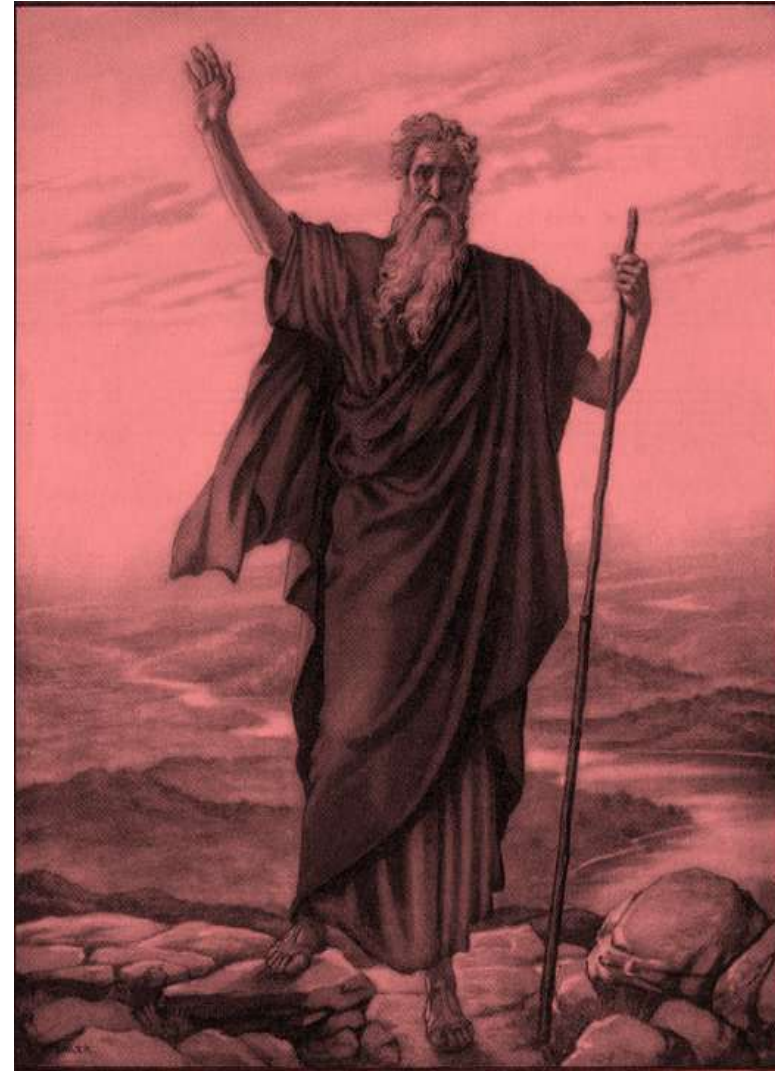
## **Moses' anger became hot** (NKJV)

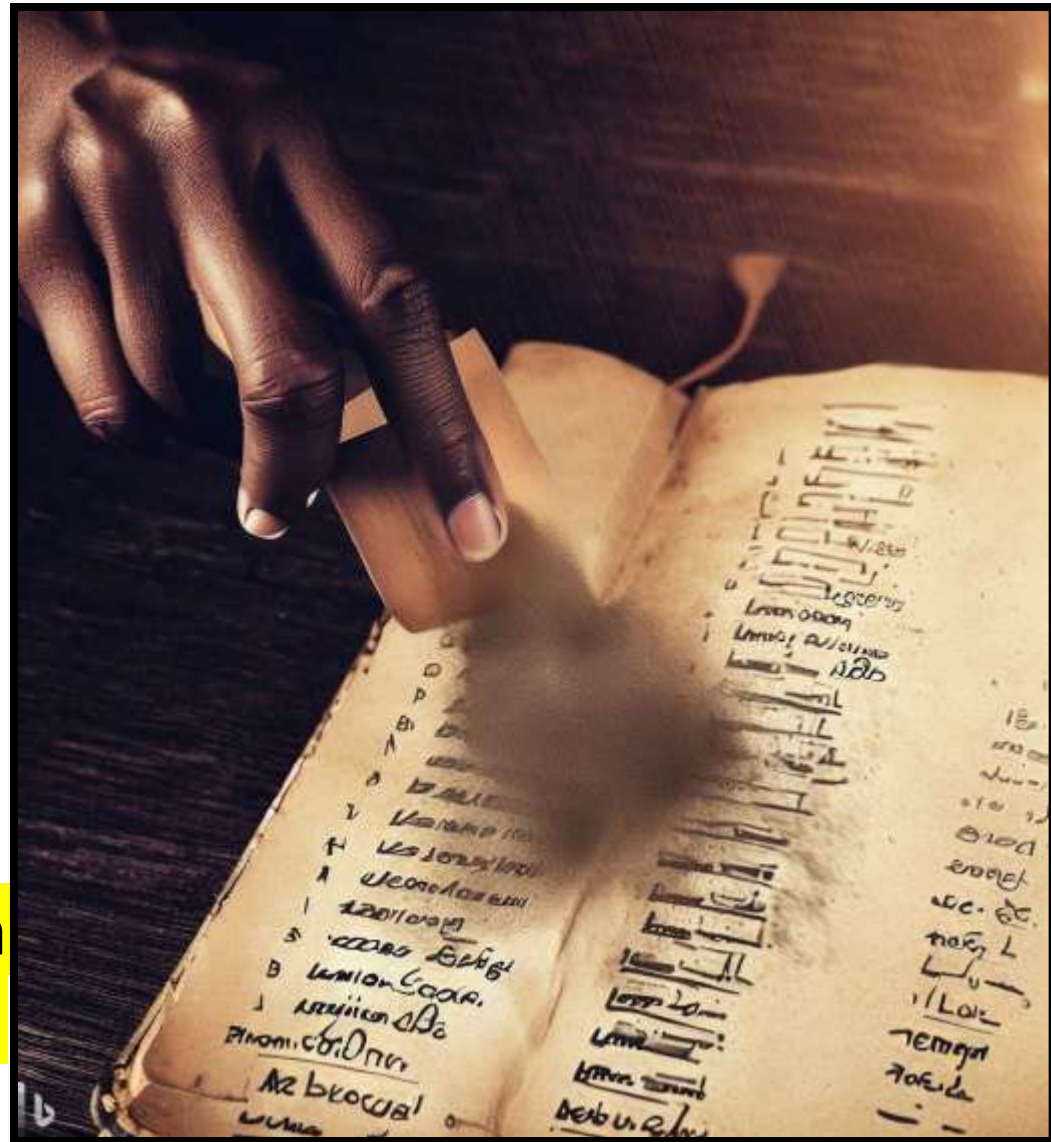


