- Heb. 12: 1-4.

- It also came from the possibility of fellowshipping with man.

- 4. He rose from the dead that we might have joy.
- I Cor. 15:20 23.
- Jesus' resurrection is the cornerstone of Christian belief.
- It proves that there will be life after death!
- It proves that not even death can keep us in the grave!

- 5. Because we will have new bodies when Jesus appears again.
- I Cor. 15:51 58.
- Jesus gives us power over death.
- We will be given immortal bodies for eternity.
- No other man/prophet, etc. can make such an offer.
- It should produce joy in our hearts!!!

- 5. Because Jesus is preparing a place for us in Heaven.
- John 14: 1-4.
- Every faithful Christian should have joy because of this.
- We will get to spend eternity with God.

- Eternal bliss is waiting for the faithful!

- 6. Because our troubles today are no comparison to our Heavenly reward.
- II Cor. 4: 16,17.

- We find joy in realizing that trials are only temporary and things will get better one day!

- 7. Because we can approach the throne of God in prayer.
- Heb. 4: 14-16.

- Romans 8: 35 -38.
