Love Is Central To Our Faith

One of the things I miss from my childhood is the fireplace we had in our home. We actually had two of them. I can remember many cold, dreary winter mornings laying in bed, pulling the covers up tight and hearing the sound of my father chopping kindling to get a fire going. It was still dark outside, there were coals in the fireplace from the fire during the night, but dad wanted to make sure there was a big fire going before my mom and I would get up in the mornings. Those roaring fires he built would fill the room with cheer and brightness as their radiant warmth pushed away the frigid winter dreariness.

The love that Jesus taught and demonstrated has that same transforming quality. When Paul wrote the First Corinthian letter, he would tell us in that great chapter on love in verse 13, "but the greatest of these is love". Just like the old family fireplace was central to the warmth of our home in the winter, so love is central to our Christian faith. Without love, there is no Christian. They would place his stretcher on the floor and he would say over and over to those who passed by, "little children, love one another." Some finally grew weary of his ceaseless repetition and asked why he always said the same thing. "because" he replied, "it is the Lord's command, and if only this is done, it is enough".


