I once read a statement where it said, "The great buildings and the powerful machines are inanimate. They cannot think and they have no economic value until loyal and interested men and women give them value through efficient use."

You see, God has no use for material things without the person who makes use of them. What possible value could a building have for God? Alone it serves no purpose as far as God is concerned. But, when people erect a building and use it to worship and serve God it becomes of great value. The same is true with money. God has no use for our money as such. The whole world belongs to Him. Being a member of the Lord's church does not assure an individual a home in heaven. It is essential, but an individual may become a member of the Lord's church and then refuse to continue faithful and lose his or her soul. Many people have not yet found the blessing in being a member of the Church because they have never used the church as a blessing. When we begin to think of the church as we should and act toward it as God expects us to, it will become a greater blessing than we ever imagined it could. greatest honor God ever bestowed on any person is the honor of being a member of the church,. Such an honor cannot be realized, however, unless we become a part of a living, active body of Christ, one which blessed the community in which it worships and serves God. Sadly, there are many who never become actively involved in the life of the church except to consider what the church can do for them. When there is a death in their family, when they are


