¹⁹ And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts; ²⁰ knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, ²¹ for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke *as they were* moved by the Holy Spirit.

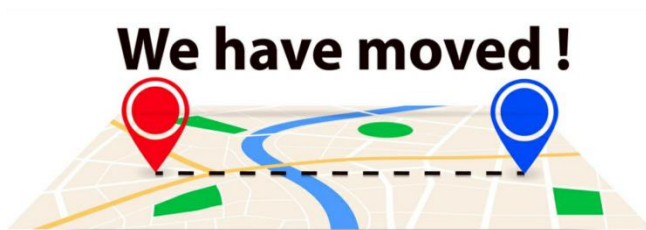

**9:00 P.M. -6:00 A.M. Citywide Curfew
for Minors**

On February 4, 2021, the East Point City Council voted to amend the existing city ordinance on curfew for minors. **The 9:00 p.m.-6:00 a.m. daily citywide curfew for minors age 17 and younger is effective immediately.**

Violations

- A parent/guardian will receive a verbal warning from a police officer on the first offense.
- On the second or subsequent offenses, a parent or guardian will be subject to a fine of up to \$1,000 or imprisonment in the East Point Municipal Jail for up to 60 days.

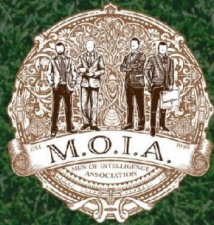

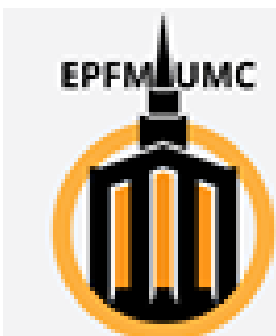

A Battle of Wills

On the field of sports, the strength of will is as important, if not more so, than the strength of body. Determination is an essential element in gaining the victory. Ecclesiastes 9:11 says, "I returned and saw under the sun that—The race is not to the swift, Nor the battle to the strong, Nor bread to the wise, Nor riches to men of understanding, Nor favor to men of skill; But time and chance happen to them all."

When David faced Goliath on the field of battle, it was not physical strength that gained David the victory. It was David's determinate faith in God that brought the giant to the ground.

In Numbers 13 there was a battle of wills. The ten spies, leaders of the people, had convinced the people of Israel that it would be deadly for them to try to go in and take the promised land. There were giants in the land; and the people lived in walled cities. On the other hand, Caleb and Joshua tried turn the will of the people to go and take the land.

This battle of wills was not between the ten spies and Caleb and Joshua. It was a battle of wills between the people of Israel and God. God had told them to go in and possess the land. He told them the land was theirs. He had even told them He would fight for them. But the people said if we go we will die and our women and children will be killed. Out of a desire for self-preservation and a fear of the peoples of the land, Israel imposed their will over the will of God, and did not go in to possess the promised land. Therefore they wandered in the wilderness for forty, yes, forty years. God had a descriptive word for these Israelites – "stiff-necked." Nine times in the Bible this is what God's inspired word calls them.

There came a time in David's life when he imposed his own will over Bathsheba and her husband Uriah. When David's sin was pointed out to him by God's prophet, Nathan, David did not seek to impose his own will over God's. Instead he repented. Psalm 51 reveals David's deep desire to submit to God's will and relinquish his own. In verse 17 he says, "The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, A broken and a contrite heart—These, O God, You will not despise." That is the antipodal (complete opposite) of "self-willed" and "stiff-necked."

"God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble" (Jam. 4:6). In the next verse James goes on to write, "Therefore submit to God." Every time a person imposes their own will in place of God's will it is wrong. Jesus Himself warned, "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven" (Mat. 7:21). Because Jesus submitted completely to His Father's will, it is written of Him...

Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:9-11

God's will, in the end, will always win out.
