However, when couples do leave their parents' homes and cling to one another (Genesis 2:24), it creates the beautiful image of their lives becoming one - just as God intended for it to be. Marriage is difficult at times, but when we include God, seeking for our own marriages what He intended, we learn the beauty of what God created. When we are one and act as one, we are stronger and more capable of overcoming the obstacles we face.
