Kyle's Korner

Matthew 24:6-7 (NKJV)

6 And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. 7 ...And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places.

The above was Jesus' reply to his disciples' questions regarding the destruction of Jerusalem and the end of the world (which they thought to be one event). Jerusalem was, in fact, destroyed in 70 A.D., just as Jesus had foretold. However, we are still here, and the world continues, seemingly as it always has.

For centuries, men and women have wondered if or when the world will end. Many friends, knowing that I am a preacher, have asked me if I believe the current pandemic to be a sign of the end of the world. Quite honestly, the thought never crossed my mind until I was asked. I do know that Jesus' return is imminent. It will come. However, do I think this is a direct sign that His coming is near? No.

I do not believe this to be a sign of Jesus' return because of the verses above. Even though the context is different, Jesus was telling His disciples not to concern themselves with these "signs." These things will always be, but it does not mean the end is near.

Matthew 24:36 (NKJV)

36 "But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only.

The truth is, we do not know when Jesus' return will be. We are, however, warned to be ready for that day, and that warning is as true now as it has always been. If you are not ready... Stop looking for signs! And prepare, before it is too late.
