What does the Bible say about respect?

Years ago, I can remember working with the Inner City Ministry with my home congregation Science Hill (Readyville). We primarily taught first graders, and I remember specifically that they often demanded our respect of them and their person, but they also seemed to fail in respecting and our authority over them. Though the situations in their homes and lives were not the norm, it seems that this same generation has grown up to be much like those first graders. There are so many that demand respect, but they fail to show respect toward others, themselves.

Jesus taught one of the greatest lessons in the "Sermon on the Mount" regarding respect. As a matter of fact, it is widely recognized today by even those outside of Christian circles, just not properly credited to Jesus. "Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets" (Matthew 7:12, NKJV). It is often referred to as "The Golden Rule."

This "rule" requires us to recognize our own desires for respect and positive treatment, also applying these desires to how we treat others. You see, Jesus taught what we should have learned from our youth, that respect is only earned when respect is given. Respect for others' property... Respect of others' privacy... Respect of others' families and their own lives... If we want others to respect us, then we must show respect to begin with.

Jesus taught many lessons on love and how it encompasses the law. Love, I believe, begins with simple respect that is earned by how we live.

SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES

The Mars Hill Church of Christ has returned to IN-PERSON MEETINGS at our building.

When assembling, we ask all members and visitors to please help us in keeping the following guidelines...

- 1) We will wear MASKS IN and we will wear MASKS OUT.
- 2) While inside we will follow SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES - 6FT. APART. We ask that, as you seat yourself, please only use EVERY OTHER PEW, leaving a pew between you and those in front or behind you. And please, NO PHYSICAL CONTACT.
- 3) For the LORD'S SUPPER, we will use pre-prepared communion cups, which include the bread. These may be picked up as you enter the building and may be disposed of as you exit.
- 4) A collection basket will be placed in the entrance for you to drop your CONTRIBUTION in without the passing of the basket.

For now, we will only physically assemble on SUNDAY MORNINGS for our 10AM WORSHIP SERVICE. This will continue until further notice.

Please be patient as, together, we navigate through this difficult and uncertain time, and until we are able to return to "normal." We appreciate your cooperation.
