SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES AND COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

When assembling, we ask all members and visitors to please help us in keeping the following guidelines...

- 1) We will wear MASKS IN, and we will wear MASKS OUT.
- 2) While inside we will follow SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES - 6FT. APART. We ask that, as you seat yourself, please only use EVERY OTHER PEW, leaving a pew between you and those in front or behind you. And please, NO PHYSICAL CONTACT.

For now, we will only meet in person on SUNDAY for 9AM BIBLE STUDY and 10AM WORSHIP. *NO SUNDAY EVENING OR WEDNESDAY EVENING SERVICES until further notice.*

In the event that we need to suspend our in-person meetings again, we will continue to SHARE THE SERVICES OF A GUEST CONGREGATION on SUNDAY MORNINGS on our Facebook page, and we will continue our EVENING DEVOTIONALS, posted to YouTube and Facebook.
