WHAT IS GOD'S GREAT PURPOSE FOR US?

I was recently asked to pray for a friend struggling to find God's purpose for their life. And I did. But as I thought more about it, it seems to me that we are under the impression that God has some kind of a specific purpose for each of us. But why? What if His "great" purpose for us is the same as it is for all?

Consider who is mentioned in Scripture that had a specific God-given purpose to fulfill. While there were those such as Noah (whom God told to build an ark) and Abraham (whom God told to sacrifice his son) and David (who slew the giant)... While they all did great things in God's service, were they serving God in a special way in which no other was able to serve, or were they simply **faithful**? Think about it! David couldn't understand why Israel didn't have a similar faith so that they might defeat Goliath and the Philistines. Noah was a "preacher of righteousness," according to 2 Peter 2:5. And what did he preach? God and the coming flood? Those around him were given opportunity to repent before this disaster took place and were called upon to be as Noah - faithful to God. Though each of these found themselves in unique situations, nothing more was required of them than of any other follower of God - faithfulness!

While it may seem noble of us to consider what great reason God has placed us here and what He wants accomplished in our lives, I am under the impression, personally, that God wants of us the same thing He wanted from all those we read about in Scripture simple **faithfulness**. He wants us to obey the gospel, in the same way He desired obedience of New Testament Christians. We can be an example to those we know, bringing the lost to Christ. And we can be **faithful** to the commands of the Scriptures.
