FALLING AWAY

Galatians 5:4 speaks of a group of Christians had become estranged from Christ and fallen from grace. While many believe that it is impossible for one to fall from grace, **these did**. Those who believe this also believe that if one were to fall away, he or she was never a faithful Christian to start with. However, in regard to the above passage, in order for those mentioned to have become "estranged from Christ," they had to have once been faithful Christians, now fallen away. In other words, the Bible does not teach the infallibility of Christians, which means we must constantly be on our guard against the temptations of Satan.

Another passage, Hebrews 10:26, tells us the result of sinning willfully **after** receiving the knowledge of the truth. Again, it is not impossible for us to sin after being saved. 2 Peter 2:21 tells us it is worse for one to turn away from his salvation than it would be had he never known salvation in the first place.

Jude 24 speaks of Jesus - "Him who is able to keep you from stumbling." If we could not fall away from faithfulness to Christ, what point would there be in encouraging Christians to put their trust in the One who can keep us from stumbling?

These are but a few passages that help us to learn the error in the "once saved, always saved" teaching.

1 Peter 3:15 (NKJV)

15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;

How many authors of the Bible are identified by name?

ANSWER: (B) 35

The correct answer is B, 35. Christians agree that God is the only True Author of the Bible; however, God used ordinary men as instruments to write the words of Scripture. Scholars estimate that around 40 different authors contributed to the Bible, but only 35 are identified by name within the text.
