Teaching preschoolers is not always the easiest job in the world, and, honestly, sometimes I wonder why I do it. But it does have its rewards, and I have tons of great memories that I think will last me a lifetime.

As a matter of fact, there are some things that I say to the kids that I would sometimes like to say to adults (if only it were appropriate)! Some things that have Biblical precedence, as well, and are good reminders for us all.

"Mind your business!" Many times I follow that statement with a question: "What should YOU be doing right now?" As adults, even, this presents difficulty for us. It is much easier to focus on others' problems rather than our own. To this, Jesus said, "And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not consider the plank in your own eye?" (Matthew 7:3). While there may be times where correcting others is necessary, it would do us well to fix our own mistakes first.

Another is: "If you have a problem with a friend, tell them, not me!" The first step in solving any conflict is to approach a brother first. "Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother" (Matthew 18:15). Now there are steps that can be taken after that, if the brother (or sister) is not receptive, but telling them first, rather than spreading gossip, is always the best way to start.

One that goes back to my original class six years ago...

"Patience is a virtue... Child!" (They will finish it if I don't, and they're not afraid to share it with their parents either!) Patience with God... Patience with people...

Waiting does not come naturally for most of us. Waiting on the Lord and being slow to anger are themes that are taught throughout the Bible, but seem to be much harder for us to implement in our lives.

So, maybe I can't always use these lines, but maybe they remind us of the behavior our "Teacher" expects of us.
