**FUN FACTS: ONLY ONCE IN THE BIBLE** 

Streets are mentioned in the Bible 136 times, but only once is a street mentioned by name. Can you recall the name of the street and within what context it is mentioned? - According to Acts 9:11, it was at the house of Judas on Straight Street in Damascus where Saul, who would later become known as Paul, would take refuge after his dramatic encounter with the Lord on the road. Ananias was then sent by the Lord to go to Paul to prepare him for his divine assignment as the apostle to the Gentiles. This is the only mention of a street with a name in Scripture. as precise as possible, though, Jeremiah es reference to a 'bakers' street' but it not appear to be a proper name. The passage in question states: "Then Zedekiah the king commanded that they should commit Jeremiah to ourt of the prison, and that they should give him daily a piece of bread from the bakers' street, until all the bread in the city was gone. Thus Jeremiah remained in the court of the prison."
