It was kind of exciting to see him in the middle of the week, like that. And as I thought about it later, two of us Christians, from the same small congregation, had the opportunity to help someone like my blind friend from work, making a positive impact on his day (something that he commented on later in the week.)

I also like that Kirk works across the street from me. At least once a month I am able to drop in and spend a few minutes talking to him - something I've really come to appreciate and look forward to.

It seems there's just something about getting to see my brothers and sisters in Christ in settings outside of church. I have many friends that are Christians that are also customers, and I've had many good Bible conversations with them over various topics while at work. It's good to be with fellow Christians on the daily!

I kind of wish we were more like the church we read about in Acts (chapters 2 & 4) that met with each other and were in each others homes all time - encouraging one another the way they did. It's not always easy, but it could be done! Is this something we can work on...???
