I FOUND IT INTERESTING... that many of our larger churches (churches of Christ, as well as denominations) were celebrating the Passover meal, this week being the week of Easter. There is a part of me that finds this to be of interest, as the tradition is very much so foreign to anything we have ever practiced within the church. I am interested in the details of it. I have seen it portrayed in television, but what was it really like to be there experiencing it all in real life?

There is another part of me that wants to raise the flag of caution, however. The reason, you might ask? We need to be very careful, as Christians, when it comes to even reenacting history, such as this. There are several that I know that honor and celebrate all of the "holy days" regarding the resurrection of Christ, and while there may be seemingly nothing wrong with it, these are things under the Old Testament law that were meant to be put away, this side of the cross.

Growing up, I heard many sermons on the dangers of using instrumental music in our worship. There are many arguments against it, but one was that we should not go back to the old law – even part of it. "In that He says, 'A new covenant,' He has made the first obsolete. Now what is becoming obsolete and growing old is ready to vanish away." (Hebrews 8:13, NKJV) This was God's intention with the cross, to put away that which the Jews had formerly practiced: the animal sacrifices, the strict rituals of the priesthood, etc. To establish the new, the old must be put to death.

To go back to even part of the old law that has been done away with may very well lead us further away from God and Christ. To teach it may become to us "another gospel", as the false doctrine Paul referred to in his letter to the Galatians (1:6-9) While a study of the past may draw our interest, we should not seek to resurrect the practices of Judaism. The cross is a representation to us of the ending of these practices. We should be careful in celebrating the resurrection to leave these things in the past.
