### HOW MAY I HELP YOU?

The above is a commonly asked question, especially in a restaurant or other business. An employee may see you waiting or wandering around and ask you this question out of genuine concern or simple etiquette, that they may be of assistance to you in some way, to help meet your needs, whatever they may be.

Do we, however, ever ask this question in regard to the church? Do we ever ask our fellow members how we may be of assistance to them - or visitors, for that matter? Do we ever consider one another and how we may fulfill each others' needs?

Your attendance to services is but one way of consider such needs. The Hebrews writer wrote: "And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together..." (Hebrews 10:24-25, NKJV) Have you ever thought about the encouragement we can be by simply attending the services of the church?

The early church is a good example to us of considering others. Luke, writing of the establishment of the church, tells us: "Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need." (Acts 2:44-45, NKJV) Seeing that there were those among them who had been in Jerusalem longer than they intended, because of all that had currently happened there, saw the needs of their brothers and sisters and sought how they might help them. They were willing to give whatever they could of their own possessions to care for the needs of their brethren, much the same way that we should seek to fulfill the needs of our brethren today. (Matthew 25:31-46)

Try asking someone how you may help them this week. Consider the needs of others, using your opportunities.
