Kyle's Korner

Last week, King Charles was crowned King of England. Being crowned the King of England, he has also become the head of the Church of England. For us in the USA, this matters little, except in interest. Because many of the things regarding the royal family are much different than anything we have here, such matters tend to draw our attention and the attention of the world.

Do you ever think, though, that we do have a king, as well? Some of our hymns are stately anthems to our king, such as: "All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name," "Crown Him with Many Crowns," and "Our King Immanuel." Such songs are drawn from our understanding of royalty and a comparison of this to our "King Jesus." He is our King – the king of our lives and head of His church (Ephesians 1:22) – in much the same way that Charles is the King of England, but also very different.

Jesus was not born into a "royal family." He was born to parents who weren't even officially married at the time. As an infant, His lowly beginnings brought him to be placed in a manger (Luke 2:7), rather than a bed or crib. Though some shepherds and wise men came to see Him and worship Him in His early life, He remained largely unknown by the worldly for His first thirty years of life. When He did finally reveal Himself as the Son of God, He was not believed, and was, instead, condemned to death.

But Jesus is our King and worthy of our adoration and praise. He is a living King, unlike the dead rulers of the past. He is a reigning King, as no one has conquered Him to take away His power and authority. Though Satan has tried, he has failed. Our King is all-powerful, almighty and ever ruling. His blood has redeemed us unto God, that as He is victorious over the powers of death and Hell itself, so we might be victorious also. He has called us to faithfulness, that we might live with Him forever.
