The Pharisees, the religious leaders of the day, focused too heavily on the letter of the law, often missing the point and making their own laws and traditions along the way. (Matthew 15:3-9) They needed to repent of "this, their wickedness," for the establishment of God's kingdom and His church was quickly to come.

We live in a quickly changing world full of sinful behavior and desires. There are many who, if they have ever loved God, have left Him for worldly pleasures. There are many that we know who are in need of repentance, that they should turn back to faithfulness and obedience to God.

(Mark 16:16) As Christians, I pray that we are not blinded to what God has promised will be.
