A TRUE AND GENUINE FAITH

Why do you believe what you believe regarding God's Word? Did you learn about God and the Bible in your childhood Sunday school classes? Did you learn about them from a friend or family member? If this is the case, why do you continue to believe? Why do you attend the services of the church? Do you attend with your parents or a spouse? Would you attend services alone if they didn't come?

All of these are valid questions regarding our faith. Where am I going with this? I want to know if your faith in God is your own, or is it borrowed? Does your faith rely on the faith others, or would your faith stand alone? Would you still act in faith without them? Is this important, and if it is, why?

Alright! Enough with the questions! Let me give some answers. Is the origin and continuance of your faith important? Yes, it is. A borrowed faith is not the kind of faith God desires of us. This kind of faith is weak and will not withstand the trials it faces. A good example is the people of Israel who remained faithful during the lives of Joshua and the elders who outlived him. However, they failed to remain faithful and obedient to God after their deaths. (Judges 2:7-10) Why? Because they failed to instill their faith in their children who basically borrowed from the faith of their parents, grandparents, etc. Their faith in God was not strong enough alone, and they were continually in and out of obedience throughout the Old Testament writings of their existence. They did not instill the same faith in their children as they should have. (Deuteronomy 6:1-9)

Our faith, instead, should be genuine. A genuine faith will truly seek God first. (Matthew 6:33) A genuine faith will lead us to obedience, keeping His commandments and following Him always. A genuine faith will ultimately lead us to our intended reward – eternity with God.
