Morning Scripture Reading: COLOSSIANS 1:24-29

- 1. HOPE IN CHRIST
  - ✓ What promises are made to Mary and Joseph regarding the Child to be born to them (Luke 1:26-33; Matthew 1:18-23)?
  - ✓ FILL-IN-THE-BLANKS: Romans 5:9 (NKJV)

✓ What reasons are we given for the shedding of Christ's blood on the cross (Romans 3:24-25; John 3:16-17; Colossians 1:19-20)?

- 2. HOPE IN CHRIST'S SACRIFICE
  - ✓ TRUE OR FALSE? Salvation is dependent upon the seriousness of the sins we have committed (1 Corinthians 6:9-11).
  - ✓ TRUE OR FALSE? For the Jews (Acts 2), remission of sins would not have been possible if they had not obeyed the gospel.
  - ✓ TRUE OR FALSE? What was required of the Jews on the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2:37-38), that they might be saved and forgiven of their sins, is also what is required of us today.
