## God's Good Gifts

This month I want to highlight the good gifts that God gives us in our December bulletins. This time of year we give and receive all kinds of gifts. Some of these gifts are good but some feel more like obligations. You know what I mean. There are times in which we may feel obligated to give a gift to someone and we struggle to know what they might actually want. We've likely received gifts that we didn't really want or need. We smile, say thank you, and write a thank you card but aren't entirely sure what to do with the item we've been given. We appreciate the gesture and may internally repeat the saying, "It's the thought that counts."

Is this what God's gifts are like? Gestures that attempt to show love but fall short in meeting our needs and desires? Absolutely not!

Every good and perfect gift comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change (James 1:17). God's gifts are never afterthoughts, never mismatched to our needs. They are always good, always perfect, always exactly what we need—even when we don't yet know we need them.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16). The Father didn't send Jesus because He felt obligated or guilt-tripped into it. He gave His very best because love gives its best. And that Gift met our deepest need—reconciliation with God—long before we knew how desperately we needed it.

But the giving didn't stop there. The Holy Spirit Himself is God's continuing gift to every believer. Jesus promised, "If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!" (Luke 11:13). Forgiveness, peace, and the ability to become children of God, joy that circumstances cannot steal—these are poured out without measure.

Paul reminds us that God "did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?" (Romans 8:32). If the Father has already given us Jesus, there is nothing good He will withhold. Every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places is already ours in Christ (Ephesians 1:3).

This December, when you unwrap packages that may or may not be needed, remember the gifts that always are: The Savior who became poor so we might become rich, the Spirit who makes His home in us, the promise that one day we will see Him face to face and know fully, even as we are fully known.

God's gifts are never obligations. They are never regifted or returned. They are perfect love, perfectly timed, perfectly suited to make us more like Jesus. Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift! (2 Corinthians 9:15).


