"Living Thankfully"

"In everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." 1Thess.5:18

Just the other day I had a deep conversation with my oldest child (we often cover some heavy topics)... but this conversation came about while talking about being thankful for what we have. Our discussion concluded in agreement that just saying thank you should not be enough but that we should live lives that say we are thankful every day.

It is certainly a good thing to give thanks to the Lord... Psalm 92:1-2 says, "It's good to give thanks to the LORD, And to sing praises to His name, O Most High; To declare Your lovingkindness in the morning, And Your faithfulness by night." ... It is a good thing to give thanks, but it is not the best thing is it? The best thing for us to do is Live Thankfully. God wants us to be thankful through how we live. Why is that?

Living Thankfully lets God know you have confidence in Him, no matter how deep the problems or how dire the circumstances. Living thankfully is faith turned inside out.

Living Thankfully changes your disposition. Instead of being down and discouraged, spreading gloom and despair everywhere you go, you begin to radiate the joy of the Lord in your life! The best ambassadors for Christ are those who are living life with a song of thanksgiving on their lips.

Living Thankfully opens the door for God to work. God hates it when we grumble and gripe... but He loves it when we praise and give thanks. As we begin to live a life of thankfulness to God, He begins to work, even through the toughest trials and tests of faith. Paul and Silas were beaten and thrown into prison... and they sang a hymn of praise to the Lord. As a result of their thankfulness even in a dark hour the prison doors were opened.

The challenge for each of us is to discipline ourselves to give thanks in everything and to live thankfully! Thank Him for the mountains ... and thank Him for the valleys. He is worthy of all your thanks/praise... **Psalm 100**, a Psalm of thanksgiving. "Shout joyfully to the LORD, all the earth. Serve the LORD with gladness; Come before Him with joyful singing. Know that the LORD Himself is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture. Enter His gates with thanksgiving, And His courts with praise. Give thanks to Him, bless His name. For the LORD is good; His lovingkindness is everlasting, And His faithfulness to all generations."... God has always urged His people to be thankful! Paul encouraged the church in Colossians **4:2** to "Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with an attitude of thanksgiving." He had already given the reason for this; it's because of what the Lord Jesus has done. He said in Col.2:6-7, "Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, and overflowing with gratitude."

Walk as you were instructed and overflow with gratitude... if we do this it will make our life brighter and better. We will be right with God and it will fill our life with joy!
